

## **Yardages and Cutting**

WOF means width of fabric from selvage to selvage. Remove as little fabric as possible when trimming selvage edges.

Note: Cutting instructions indicated with an \* indicate directional fabric and should be cut exactly as listed.

#### 1/4 yard pink dot, 120-00041

1 strip 2-1/2" x WOF; cut into (3) 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces and (3) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces 1 strip 1-1/2" x WOF; cut into (3) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces and (3) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces

1/4 yard blue dot, 120-00042 1/4 yard green dot, 120-00043 1/4 yard orange dot, 120-00044 From each fabric cut:

1 strip 2-1/2" x WOF; cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces and (2) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces 1 strip 1-1/2" x WOF; cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces and (2) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces

### 5/8 yard pink pencil, 120-00021\*

4 strips 1-1/2" x 18" cut lengthwise; cut (1) strip into (1) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" piece and (1) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" piece

1 strip 4" x WOF; cut into (6) 2-1/2" x 4" pieces, (3) 1-1/2" x 4" and (3) 1-1/2" x 3" pieces (pencils should run the short way across each piece)

1 strip 2-1/2" x WOF; cut into (3) 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" pieces and (6) 1-1/2" x 2" pieces (pencils should run the length of each piece)

### 5/8 yard blue pencil, 120-00022\* 5/8 yard green pencil, 120-00023\* 5/8 yard orange pencil, 120-00024\* From each fabric cut:

4 strips 1-1/2" x 18" cut lengthwise; cut (1) strip into (1) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" piece and (1) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" piece

1 strip 4" x WOF; cut into (4) 2-1/2" x 4" pieces, (2) 1-1/2" x 4" and (2) 1-1/2" x 3" pieces (pencils should run the short way across each piece)

1 strip 2-1/2" x WOF; cut into (2) 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" pieces and (4) 1-1/2" x 2" pieces (pencils should run the length of each piece)

#### 3/8 yard gray telephone, 120-00006

2 strips 4" x WOF: cut into (18) 4" squares

### 1-1/8 yards black phone book, 120-00057\*

1 strip 3-1/2" x WOF; cut into (4) 3-1/2" squares and (9) 2" squares
1 strip 3" x WOF; cut into (18) 2" x 3" pieces
2 strips 2" x WOF; cut into (18) 2" x 4-1/2" pieces

7 strips 2-1/4" x WOF for binding

#### 1-1/8 yards gray dot, 120-00046

9 strips 3-1/2" x WOF; cut into (10) 3-1/2" x 17" pieces and (10) 3-1/2" x 11" pieces

#### 7/8 yard gray pencil, 120-00026\*

4 strips 3-1/2" x WOF; cut into (8) 3-1/2" x 17" pieces

(pencils should run the length of each piece) 1 strip 11" x WOF; cut into (8) 3-1/2" x 11" pieces

(pencils should run the short way across each piece)

### 5/8 yard gray ink pen, 120-00036

5 strips 3-1/2" x WOF

### 3-3/4 yards backing fabric of choice

2 pieces 66" x WOF for backing


#### Batting

1 piece 66" x 66"

# **Piecing the Blocks**


Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press seams toward each piece as it is added.


1. Sew (1) 1-1/2" x 2" pink pencil piece to the bottom of (1) 2" black phone book square. Sew (1) 1-1/2" x 3" pink pencil piece to the left side, and then add (1) 2" x 3" black phone book piece. Sew (1) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" pink dot piece to the top edge and (1) 2" x 4-1/2" black phone book piece to the bottom.





2. Sew (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pink dot piece to the bottom. Sew (1) 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" pink dot piece to the left side and (1) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" pink dot piece to the right side.





3. Sew (1)  $2^n \times 4-1/2^n$  black phone book piece lengthwise to (1)  $2-1/2^n \times 4-1/2^n$  pink pencil piece. Sew to the right side of (1)  $1-1/2^n \times 4^n$  pink pencil piece. Sew (1)  $4^n \times 4^n$  gray telephone square to the left side. Sew (1)  $2-1/2^n \times 4^n$  pink pencil piece to the right side.






4. Sew (1) 2" x 3" black phone book piece to (1) 1-1/2" x 2" pink pencil piece. Sew (1) 2-1/2" x 4" pink pencil piece to the right side. Sew (1) 4" gray telephone square to the bottom.







5. Sew the unit from step 4 to the right side of the unit from step 2. Sew the unit from step 3 to the top to complete the block center.




6. Sew 3-1/2" x 11" gray dot strips to opposite sides of the block center. Sew 3-1/2" x 17" gray dot strips to the top and bottom to complete the 17" square block.





7. In the same way, make 1 additional pink block, 1 blue block, and 2 orange blocks with the gray dot block border. Make 1 pink block, 1 blue block and 2 green blocks with the gray pencil border.



# **Completing the Quilt**

- 1. Lay out the (9) blocks into 3 rows of 3 blocks each, noting orientation. Sew the blocks into rows. Press seams toward the gray dot blocks. Join the rows to complete the quilt center. Press seams in 1 direction.

  2. Sew (5) 3-1/2" x WOF gray ink pen strips short ends together. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into (4) 50"
- 2. Sew (5) 3-1/2" x WOF gray ink pen strips short ends together. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into (4) 50" lengths.
- 3. Sew (3) 1-1/2" x 18" orange pencil strips short ends together. Press seams to 1 side. Trim to measure 50". Sew lengthwise to (1) 3-1/2" x 50" gray ink pen strip to make a pieced border strip. Press seams to 1 side. Repeat to make (1) pieced border strip each using green, pink and blue pencil stripes.
- 4. To make a corner border unit, sew (1) 1-1/2"  $\times$  3-1/2" orange pencil piece to the bottom of (1) 3-1/2" black phone book square. Press seam toward black square. Sew (1) 1-1/2"  $\times$  4-1/2" blue pencil piece to the right side. Press seam toward black square to complete (1) 4-1/2" square unit. Referring to the diagrams for color placement, make (4) different corner border units.













- 5. Sew the blue and green pieced border strips to opposite sides of the guilt center. Sew corner border units to opposite ends of the orange and pink pieced border strips, matching colors correctly, and then sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt center. 6. Remove the selvedge edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a 1/2" seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make a 66" square backing piece.
- 7. Layer, baste and quilt and use the 2-1/4" x WOF black phone book strips to bind the quilt.


