


Pocket Apron



featuring the Otter Romp collection





Otter Romp

You'll Need

- 1/2 yard of pink tree print
- 1/2 yard orange otter stripe
- 1/3 yard orange constellation print
- Fat quarter Painter's Palette Solids Impatient
- 1/4 yard fusible interfacing

Cutting

From the pink tree print:


(1) 27" x 16" piece

From the orange otter stripe:

(1) 27" x 16" piece



From the orange constellation print:

(2) 3" x WOF strips




Make the Apron

1. To create the apron shape, cut out the apron edge cutaway template. Fold the 27" x 16" pink tree print piece in half wrong sides together so it measures 27" x 8". Position the apron edge template on the lower left edge of the folded fabric as shown and pin in place. Cut out the template section. Flip template and repeat on lower right corner as well.



2. Repeat step 1 using the 27" x 16" orange otter stripe piece for the apron lining.


3. Trace the heart shape onto the paper side of fusible web and cut out roughly around line. Fuse to the wrong side of the Impatient Pink fabric and cut out on the drawn line. If desired, zigzag stitch rounded edges of heart for finished edge. Position heart on the pink tree apron piece approximately 3" from bottom edge and 6-1/2" from left edge. Stitch bottom of heart to the apron to create a pocket, backstitching near rounded heart tops to secure.




4. To make the waist tie, fold (1) 3" x WOF orange constellation strip in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and press. Unfold, then fold each long edge in to the center fold and press. Refold on the center line and pin the folded edges. Topstitch 1/4" from the folded edge. Fold (1) raw edge in 1/4" and then in another 1/4" to create a finished edge. Stitch to secure. Repeat with the second orange constellation strip.



5. Lay the pink tree apron piece flat with the right side facing up. Pin the raw edge end of an orange tie along the left side, approximately 1/2" from the top. Repeat on the right side.



6. Layer orange otter stripe apron lining on top, right side down. Make sure apron ties are tucked inside. Pin to secure the layers and sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Leave an 8" opening along one short side.
7. Turn apron right side out through the opening. Press the raw edges in and topstitch the
