Throw Quilt | 64" x 64"



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Fabric Requirements

Fabric quantities are based on 42" WOF (width of fabric) and makes a **throw size quilt** (64" x 64"). Print fabrics are from Mable Tan's Birds and Blossoms collection for Paintbrush Studio Fabrics (PBS) and solid fabrics are also by Paintbrush Studio Fabrics.

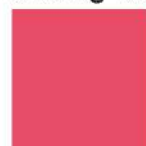

Cutting Directions

Cutting dimensions include 1/4" seam allowances. Remove selvages.

	Throw Size Quilt
Fabric A to D (Background)	Each Fabric A to D cut: 2 strips 10" x WOF, sub-cut: • 6 squares, 10" x 10"
Fabric E (Bricks)	6 strips 10" x WOF, sub-cut: • 24 squares, 10" x 10"
Fabric F to M (Birds and Blossoms)	Each Fabric F to M cut: 1 strip 10" x WOF, sub-cut: • 4 squares, 10" x 10"
Fabric O (Binding Fabric)	7 strips, 2 1/2" x WOF



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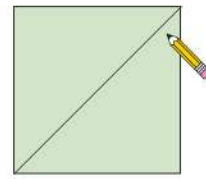
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Half-Square Triangles Units

2-in-1 half-square triangle method will be used in the following section. Completed Half-Square Triangle units will be split in half to create Hourglass units in a later section of the quilt pattern.

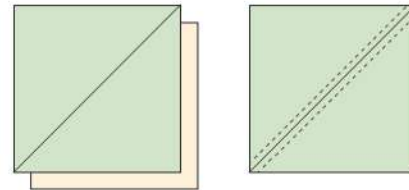
Step 1: Mark a diagonal guideline on the reverse side of:

- 6 Fabric A 10" x 10" squares
- 6 Fabric B 10" x 10" squares
- 6 Fabric C 10" x 10" squares
- 6 Fabric D 10" x 10" squares
- 16 Fabric E 10" x 10" squares



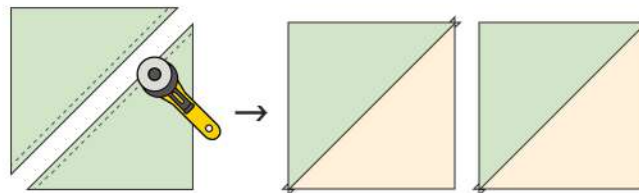
Fabric A 10" x 10" square used in this example

Step 2: With right sides together, pair 10" x 10" squares. Place square with marked guideline on top and sew 1/4" line on both sides of the drawn line. See fabric pairs required in the table below and on the following page.

































Fabric A and E 10" x 10" squares used in this example

Step 3: Cut on drawn line and press seams open to create two half-square triangle (HST) units.

Step 4: Mark a diagonal guideline on the reverse sides of all Half-Square Triangle units. Cut on the guidelines to create a total of:

*Note: There will be four extra Split-HST units for each Fabric A/F, A/G, B/H, B/I, C/J, C/K, D/L and D/M. These can be combined to create a baby size quilt.

















































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Hourglass Units

Step 1: Pair and combine Split-HST units as shown in the table below, and press the seams open.

To avoid seam-ripping moments, it is important to note the orientation of each Split-Half-Square Triangle unit from the previous step before sewing the Hourglass units.

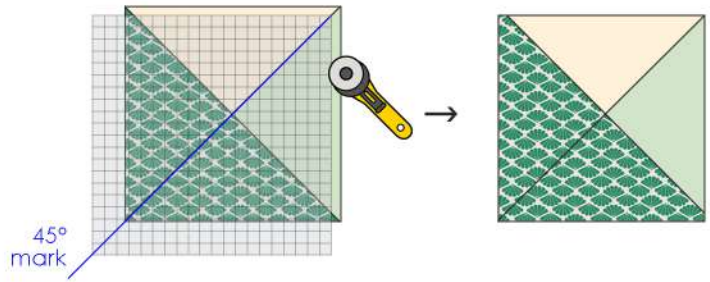
Tip: A way to avoid any confusion is to separate the Split Half-Square Triangle units into 32 piles based on colour and orientation. Label each pile with post-it notes or write on a piece of painter's tape.

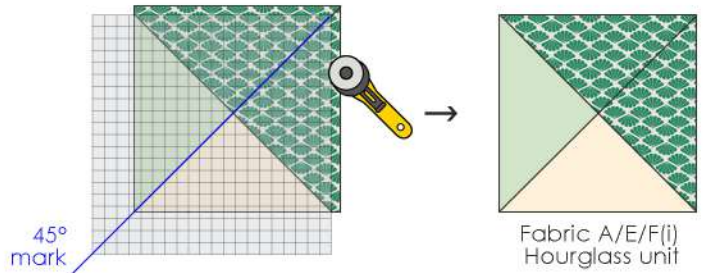
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Hourglass Units (cont.)

Step 2: Square up all hourglass units to $8\frac{1}{2}$ " squares by matching the intersection of the $4\frac{1}{4}$ " line on the ruler with the centre seams of the Hourglass units **and** the 45-degree mark on the ruler with the diagonal seam line (as shown in the diagram on the right), and trim the top and right edges of the units.



Step 3: Rotate each Hourglass unit 180-degrees and repeat Step 2 with the remaining two sides.

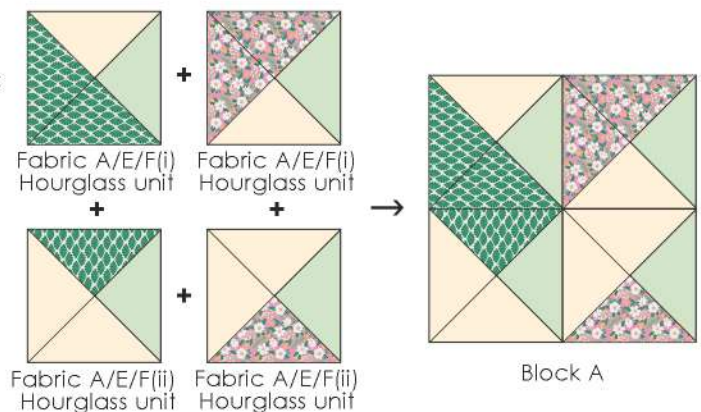


*Fabric A/E/F(i) Hourglass unit used in this example

Block Assembly

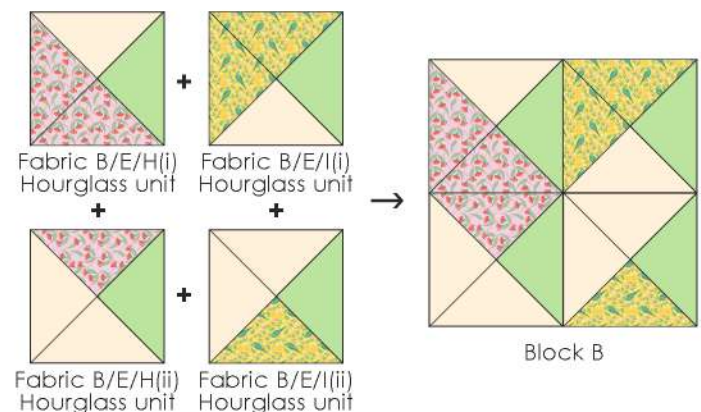
Step 1: As shown in the diagram, form a **Block A** unit by sewing together 1 Fabric A/E/F(i) Hourglass unit, 1 Fabric A/E/F(ii) Hourglass unit, 1 Fabric A/E/G(i) Hourglass unit, and 1 Fabric A/E/G(ii) Hourglass unit. Press the seams open.

Repeat this step to create a total of **4 Block A** units.



Step 2: Combine 1 Fabric B/E/H(i) Hourglass unit, 1 Fabric B/E/H(ii) Hourglass unit, 1 Fabric B/E/I(i) Hourglass unit and 1 Fabric B/E/I(ii) Hourglass unit to form a **Block B** unit. Press the seams open.

Repeat this step to create a total of **4 Block B** units.



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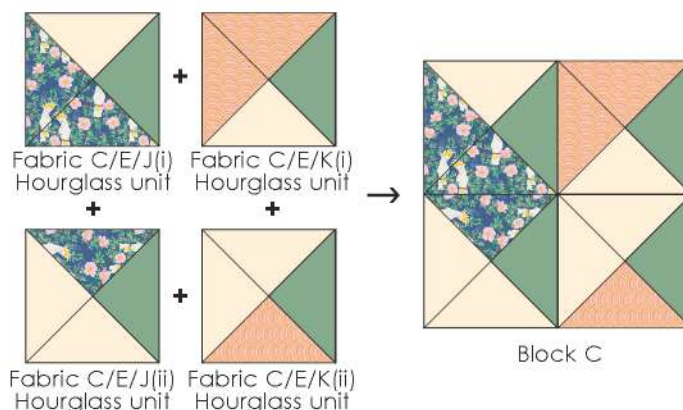
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Block Assembly (cont.)

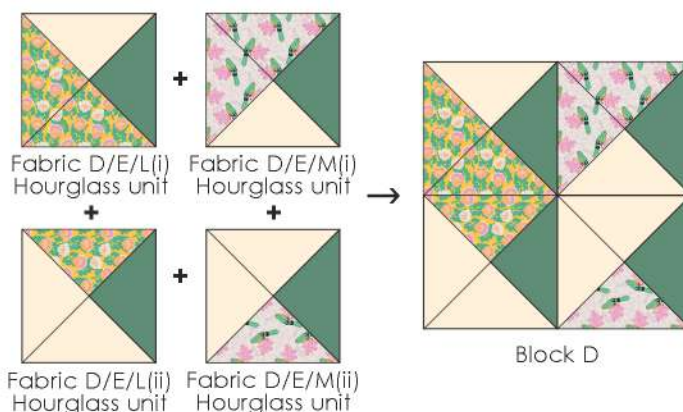
Step 3: Create a **Block C** unit by combining 1 Fabric C/E/J(i) Hourglass unit, 1 Fabric C/E/J(ii) Hourglass unit, 1 Fabric C/E/K(i) Hourglass unit, and 1 Fabric C/E/K(ii) Hourglass unit. Press the seams open.

Repeat this step to create a total of **4 Block C** units.



Step 4: Sew together 1 Fabric D/E/L(i) Hourglass unit, 1 Fabric D/E/L(ii) Hourglass unit, 1 Fabric D/E/M(i) Hourglass unit, and 1 Fabric D/E/M(ii) Hourglass unit to create a **Block D** unit. Press the seams open.

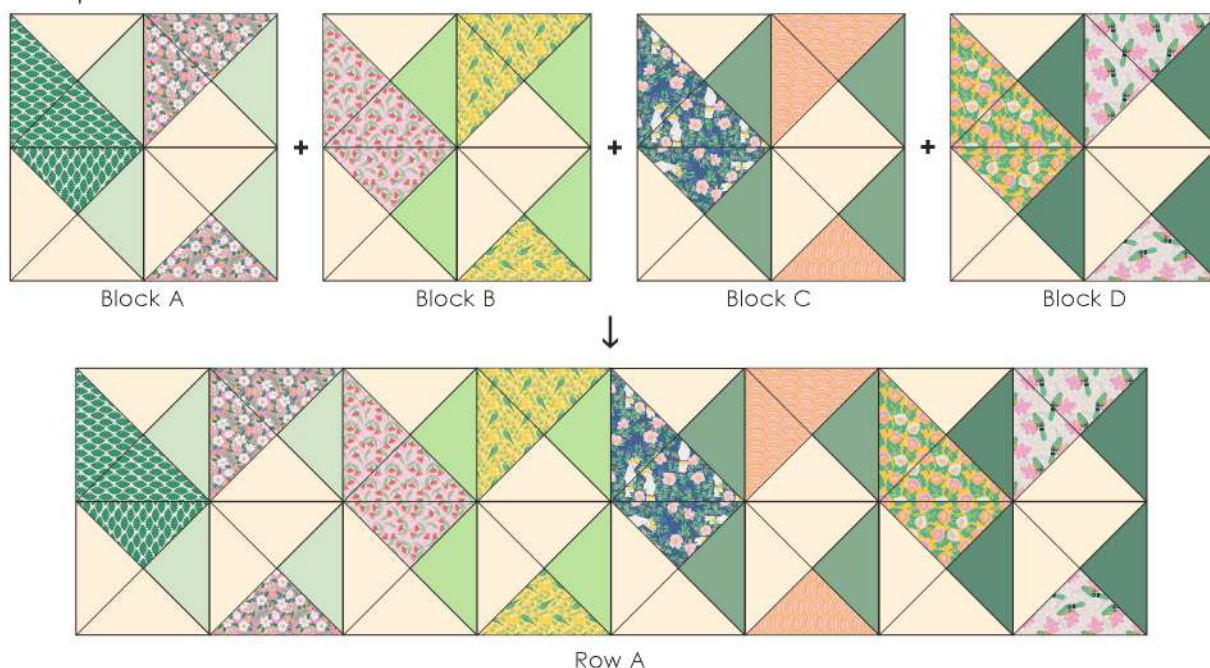
Repeat this step to create a total of **4 Block D** units.



Quilt Assembly

Step 1: Combine 1 Block A unit, 1 Block B unit, 1 Block C unit and 1 Block D unit to form **Row A** unit, as shown in the diagram below. Press the seams open.

Repeat to create a total of **4 Row A** units.



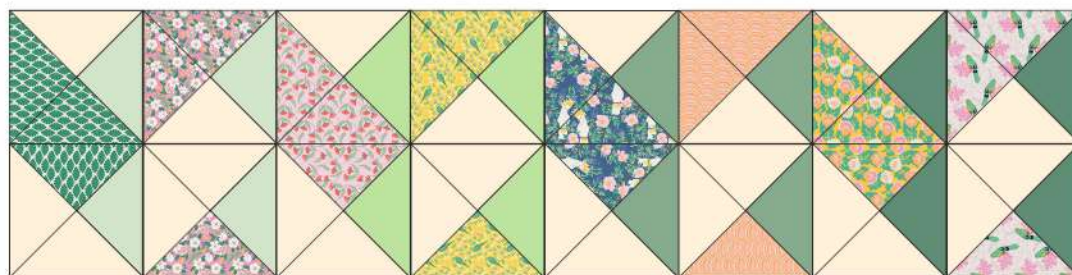
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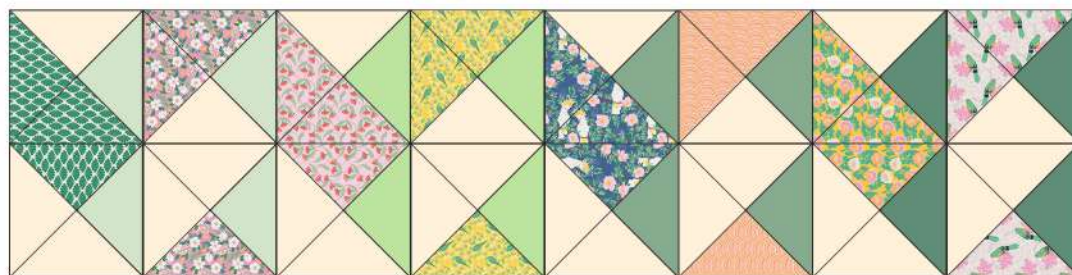
Quilt Assembly (cont.)

Step 2: Sew together all Row A units to form **Quilt Top**. Press the seams open.



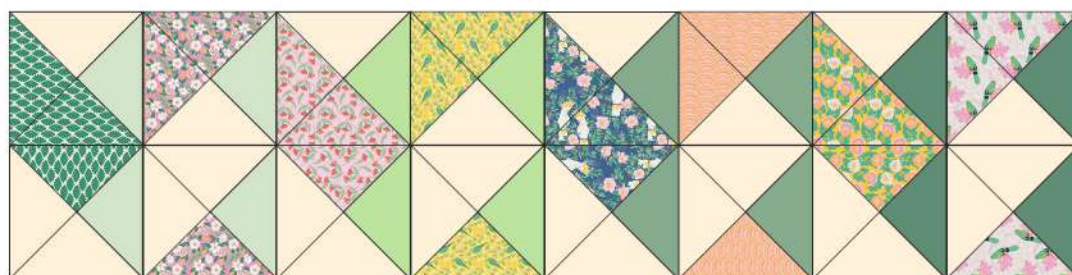

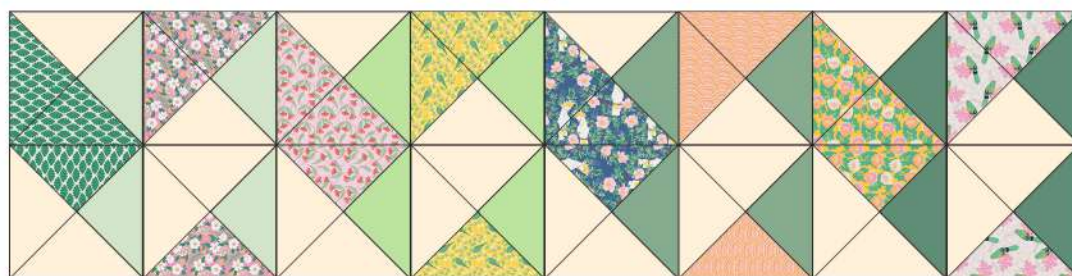

Step 3: Finish the project using your preferred basting, quilting and binding methods.



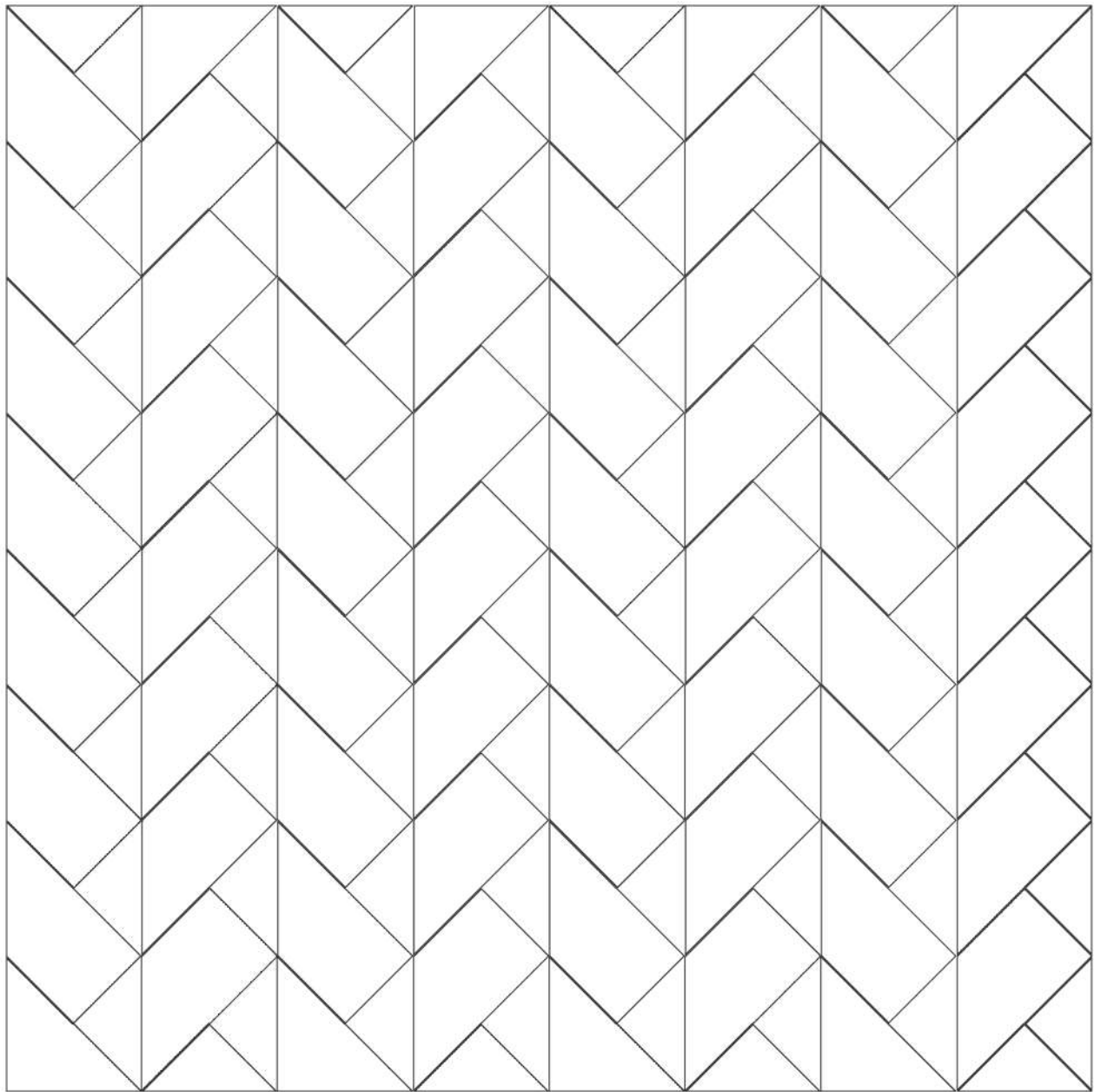
