PREP: For this installation, you will need a 4mm Allen wrench or socket wrench and blue Loctite.



STEP 2: Clean the stock screw and apply blue Loctite to it. Use a 4mm Allen wrench to install the Stainless Weighted Bar End with the stock screw. Tighten until snug.




STEP 1: Use a 4mm Allen wrench to remove the right stock bar end.




Right Stainless Weighted Bar End Installation complete!
