
Picture Lights

Picture lights provide a simple, stylish way to highlight artwork and photography while adding layers of lighting to a space. As a rule of thumb, the width of your picture light should be about half the width of the frame or artwork. When a fixture in that exact size isn't available, choose the next larger width to ensure your piece is properly illuminated. For best results, position the light at a 30-degree angle from the artwork so illumination is even and glare is minimized. Attention to both width and angle keeps the art as the visual focal point, beautifully showcased within your space.
