INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

- 1: Remove lid and place wax inside the nonstick pot
- 2. Plug the lead into your power supply and touch the 'Power On' () symbol to turn machine on
- 3. To set desired temperature, press + to increase the temperature and/or to reduce the temperature
- 4. The wax heater will begin to warm the wax automatically.
- 5. You can set the LED temperature display by selecting the °C/°F symbol

WAX HEATING RECOMMENDATIONS:

Suggested temperature to melt Hard and Strip Wax is at a maximum of 120 °C. Suggested temperature to melt Hard Wax and Strip Wax in a silicone or removable pot is 165°C.

Always test temperature of wax before applying to skin.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Disconnect heater from its direct power supply
- 2. Using a soft cloth and a non evasive cleaner, gently wipe away wax. It is recommended Barneys Wax Remover Citrus Cleaner is used to cleans away excess wax in and/or on the wax heater. In order to help keep your wax heater in optimal condition, be sure to follow up with a gentle wipe using a clean soapy cloth

DO NOT:

- 1. Use other solvents to clean the wax heater or you may damage the non-stick coating
- 2. Use sharp instruments to clean or scrape wax residue
- 3. Immerse wax heater under water or soak wax heater parts
- 4. Clean heater with excess solutions or water

CAUTIONS:

- 1. Never immerse your wax heater in water
- 2. Always unplug device when setting down and whilst cleaning
- 3. Ensure the device is kept on a stable surface when in use
- 4. Check the voltage of your power source is compatible with the wax heater before use
- 5. Always keep out of reach of children and pets
- 6. Never use next to a water source, bath tubs or sinks
- 7. Keep the wax heater out of direct sunlight and ultraviolet radiation
- 8. Remember to unplug the wax heater before removing wax pots or tins
