
#### 2. Warning

- Do not use in wet environments (such as a bathroom or spa area).
- Turn the power off after operation.
- Please disconnect the product from the power source if it is not being used for a long period of time.
- Clean the lamp head and cover it properly for storage.
- Wipe the lens with a soft lens cloth. Do not wipe with paper towel or other materials to avoid damage.
- · Avoid contact of liquids with the brightness switch or other electric componeents when adjusting the device.
- · Avoid direct light to the eyes. Protect eyes from direct light.
- If the external power cable is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, a certified electical service agent, or a qualified electrician to avoid hazards.
- WARNING "Material" (IEC 60417-6042): The light source can only be replaced by the manufacturer or qualified service agent.
- Do not use alcohol or other organic solvent to clean the lens.


# **WARNING!**

- Do not use acidic or alkaline substances with this product.
- Do not move this product whilst it is in use or whilst it is directly plugged into a power supply.
- Do not use or store this product in an environment containing acidic gas or humid air to avoid malfunction and other dangers.
- Do not use this product near high-temperature and high-heating objects.
- Do not use this product near flammable objects or flammable liquids.

# Operation method

- 1) Connect the "Power" supply.
- ② Turn on the "Power" button. Open the plastic cover and align the magnifying lamp with the treatment zone.
- ③ Adjust brightness and the distance between the lamp and skin to achieve the clearest illumination. (4 levels of brightness).
- Examine the skin or begin beauty treatment. Brightness can be adjusted during operation.

#### 7. Maintenance

- After every treatment, use a neutral solution to clean dust and stains.
   Avoid using cleaning solutions such as alcohol, acid or alkaline solutions that could damage the surface. This is to prevent the lifetime of the components from being shortened.
- 2. Please lubricate the moving parts regularly (at least once a year).
