DYE COLORS OVERVIEW

#1 Black

a classic color for eyelash tinting. Being mixed with other colors from the palette, darkens them or helps to create colder shades during eyebrow tinting. Has a cold base and purple core.

#2 Graphite

a shade of medium intensity for tinting the eyebrows of raven-haired clients or those having cold blond hair (ash or pearl blond). Has a blue-green core and cold base

#3 Blue Black

a deep and intense shade for eyelash tinting. Perfect for those who want more than regular black. It can also be used to neutralize yellowness. Has a cold base and blue core.

#4 Chestnut

a non-intense shade that is perfect for tinting the eyebrows of medium blond types. Has a yellow-green core and neutral base.

#4.1 Red Chestnut

an intense red shade for ginger, red and mahogany hair color. Used for creating new colors and correction of unwanted shades. Has a warm base and red-orange core.

#5 Light Brown

a shade of medium intensity, perfect for clients with red, medium-blond and fair hair with **straw, golden or ash tone**. Has a yellow core and warm base

#6 Brown

an intense shade for clients with dark-blond hair. Has a blue-green core and neutral base.

#7 Dark Brown

an intense shade for clients with tanned skin and dark hair. Has a blue-green & dark green core and cold base.



BLOND

use in pure form for







(the shades are presented according to the intensity of a mix: from light to dark one)

in its pure form this neutral shade perfectly matches different types of fair hair

#5 (50%) #2 (50%) cold fair shade*

#5 (60%) #6 (40%) warm fair shade*

^{*} both mixes have approximately the same intensity but differ in temperature

GINGER

- in its pure form for ginger hair with golden tone
- in its pure form this neutral shade perfectly matches ginger hair of medium intensity
- in its pure form for intense red hair
- #4(50%) #5(50%) warm medium intensity
- #5 (50%) #4.1 (50%) intense red shade

DARK BLOND, CHESTNUT

in its pure form for dark blond hair

#4(50%) #2(50%) cold

#4(90%) #1(10%) neutral brown shade

#6(80%) #4.1(20%) warm

#7 (90%) #4.1 (10%) warm

- GRAPHITE blue-green core, cold base
- #4
- CHESTNUT yellow-green core, neutral base
- #5 LIGHT BROWN
 yellow core, warm base
- #6

BROWN blue-green core, neutral base

Mixing these shades, one can create mixes practically for any client.

FACTORS THAT AFFECT THE TINTING RESULT OF A MIX

- SKIN TYPE (dry, normal, oily)
- HAIR TYPE (thin, normal, thick)
- CONDITION OF HAIR CUTICLE (porosity)
- INDIVIDUAL PECULIARITIES (hormonal changes, medication intake)
- OBSERVANCE OF SAFETY RULES WHEN WORKING WITH AN OXIDIZER (using Milk-cream Developer BRONSUN in correct proportions)
- TECHNIQUE OF APPLYING A DYE (application in a thin layer)
- **EXPOSURE TIME OF A DYE** (7-20 minutes on eyebrows)
- CORRECT PREPARATION OF THE EYEBROW AREA for tinting
