WARNING:

- Do not look directly into the sun with the binoculars as it can cause permanent damage to your eyes.

PARTS:

1. Right Eye Focusing Ring
2. Focusing Wheel
3. Barrel



HOW TO USE:

Adjust field of view:

1. Hold and aim the binoculars at your subject.
2. Move the barrels either apart or closer together until you have a single field of view. The subject should not be doubled.

Focus:

1. Make sure the right eye focusing ring is turned all the way to the right.
2. Cover the right lens with your hand.
3. Adjust the focusing wheel while looking through the left lens until the image is at its sharpest. Keep both eyes open while making this adjustment.
4. Next, cover the left lens with your hand.
5. Adjust the right eye focusing ring while looking through the right lens until the image is at its sharpest. Keep both eyes open while making this adjustment.
6. Now, look through the binoculars with the lenses uncovered. It may take your eyes a moment to adjust but the image will come in clear.
