


# **Instruction Manual for**




## **PARTS**

- 1. Thermometer
- 2. Hygrometer– measures humidity
- LED Penlight a. LED Penlight On/Off
- Mirror
- Level
- 6. Compass
- 7. Whistle (push out with hook)
- 8. Flint Fire Starter (push out with hook)b. Striker (push out with hook)
- 9. Magnifier (slides out)
- 10. Ruler

\*Note: You can push out the whistle, fire starter, or striker by sliding the hook through the holes in the other side of the tool

### Assembling the striker:



#### Starting a fire:

- Build a fire making sure you are in a location that is clear of trees and other objects. Make sure wood and kindling are dry.
- 2. Hold the fire starter away from you and pointed near tinder and kindling.
- 3. Slide the striker quickly against the rod away from you and towards tinder.
- 4. This will create a spark and should light tinder on fire.

WARNING: This is not a toy. Fires should only be started by adults or under adult supervision. Do not use indoors. Make sure your fire pit is in a safe location away from flammables. If possible, keep a bucket of water on hand when starting and during the fire. Make sure fire is fully extinguished before leaving unattended.

#### Replacing the Penlight Battery:

When the penlight begins to dim even after a full charge, you can replace the rechargeable battery. Unscrew the plate with the level and insert 2 new "CR 1220 3V" batteries into the tool.
