## How to Play Shuffleboard

To keep the playing surface flat, place the two magnetic bars on each end of the board.

- There are four discs for each team. Both teams start at the same end of the board. One team will launch from the left side and the other will launch from the right.
- 2. Toss a coin to see who plays first. It's advantageous to go second.
- 3. To launch a disc, place it on the "10 Off" section in front of you and cast from there.
  - a. Discs must cross the first line.
  - b. Discs must remain fully on the board. Any discs that are off or partially on the board are removed from play.
- 4. Alternate casting the discs across the board until all the discs are in play. The goal is to reach the triangle on the other side of the board and to also knock your opponent's discs out of play or out of scoring position.
  - a. You must land completely in a section in order to score that section's points. If you land on a line, you lose 5 points.
  - b. If you land in the "10 Off" section, you lose 10 points
- After all the discs are cast and points tallied, you then start the next round going in the opposite direction. Each round alternates direction until a team reaches 75 points and wins.
