PUBLISHING PROPOSAL FORM

Thank you for your interest in Leuven University Press, in particular in the book series 'Translation, Interpreting & Transfer' (TI&T).

This form is intended to help you to submit your book proposal or a (preliminary) manuscript for review. After having received this document and all necessary attachments, we will prepare your file for further evaluation. Your proposal or manuscript will first be presented to the TI&T editorial board for initial assessment. You will be notified of the outcome immediately after that first assessment.

Following a positive response of the editorial board and a financial assessment made by the publisher we will send your final manuscript to two specialist readers for expert advice. This review takes approximately two months after the acceptance of the reviewer. The final publishing decision is dependent on the advice of the reviewers and cannot be contested.

Your manuscript may be accepted as it is, or (in most cases) you may be asked to make some necessary changes. Should we receive a substantively negative report from a reviewer, we will not publish the manuscript. You will be provided with the anonymous reviewer reports, for your reference. It takes approximately 4-6 months from the date of submitting an accepted, final manuscript for production until you have the final book publication in hand.

TI&T only accepts manuscripts in English. We look forward to receiving your proposal or manuscript!

4. Open Access and KU Leuven Fund for Fair Open Access

In order to stimulate authors to publish their work in Fair OA, KU Leuven has established a Fund for Fair OA. This fund provides financial support to (partly) cover the publishing costs of eligible OA books and articles.

All researchers who wish to publish an OA book with Leuven University Press are eligible to apply for funding for book processing charges (BPCs). Authors affiliated with KU Leuven can apply for 2/3 of the BPC, the remaining 1/3 has to be financed by their own funds. Authors who do not have access to such funds can apply for a fee waiver, thus effectively receiving financial support for the whole BPC. Authors not affiliated with KU Leuven University can apply for 1/3 of the BPC and will have to provide the remaining 2/3 themselves.
