Leuven University Press, established in 1971 under the auspices of the KU Leuven, is an ambitious academic press of international standing.

Over the past 45 years Leuven University Press has remained true to its commitment to disseminate scholarly knowledge and support academic research by publishing books, series and periodicals. Today the press has titles in print in a broad range of fields, including music, art & theory, architecture, media & visual culture, text & literature, history & archaeology, philosophy, society, gender & diversity.

All publications are published with care and attention to detail. Prior to publication, all manuscripts are assessed by an independent editorial board and external specialist readers to ensure the highest academic standards. Combined with a service-oriented and personal approach, this peer review process defines our publishing policy.



Open Access Books

Leuven University Press supports Open Access and offers two different roads to Open Access: the green road or so-called 'self-archiving' and the golden road scenario where the book appears in full Open Access from the first day of publication.

Peer review is standard procedure. All new proposals and manuscripts considered for publication, whether Open Access or not, are presented to an independent editorial board.

LUP is recognized by the European Research Council (ERC), the Wellcome Trust, and the Austrian Science Fund (FWF) as a publisher that complies with the OA requirements and has been granted access to the OAPEN Library. In this way LUP offers a sustainable publication model that guarantees global impact, dissemination and digital preservation.



(Y)our Books & Articles Worldwide

Leuven University Press is committed to bringing its publications to the attention of a targeted, global audience of readers through an extensive network of representatives and distributors. Findability and availability are key words in this endeavour.

In the USA and Canada all English titles are distributed and sold through our publishing partner Cornell University Press. In Europe our titles are distributed by NBN International. In the Netherlands all titles are available via CB. A selection of our titles is available in France through FMSH-diffusion and in China our titles are distributed by Inspirees.

In addition to this international network of distributors, booksellers and library suppliers, Leuven University Press also makes use of digital publishing tools such as Google Books, Amazon.com and existing ebook platforms to promote and market LUP titles.

A number of our titles are also available as ebooks on our website www.lup.be and through selected online booksellers and library platforms such as Proquest, EBSCOhost, Dawsonera, Project Muse and JSTOR.

Facts and Figures

- LUP is a global press: our books go worldwide and our authors come from everywhere.
- Only 50% of the authors have a link with KU Leuven, the other 50% are affiliated with international institutions abroad.
- We keep a title available for at least 5 years and longer if sales allow for this.
- The average list price of a scholarly monograph produced in paperback is 40 €.
- We publish in English, but also offer room for publications in Dutch or French.
- Our newsletter is sent out to approx. 3,000 subscribers; our website www.lup.be has more than 5,000 unique visitors per month.
