Why publish books in Open Access?

Open Access stands for:

- Disseminating research more effectively
- Increasing public access
- Boosting impact
- Digital preservation
- High-quality control

Open Access (OA) embodies the **ideal of scholarly communications**: scholarly knowledge that is accessible worldwide, peer-reviewed, and professionally provided. It offers advantages for authors, researchers, and libraries. For authors it extends the reach of their work and increases citation rates as well as the societal impact of their publications. Researchers benefit from worldwide access and retrievability. Libraries can provide wider access to scholarly information.



Why publish with Leuven University Press?

True to its commitment to disseminate scholarly knowledge and to support academic research, Leuven University Press has the **expertise and resources** to publish books in full Open Access.

1. **Quality control:** Peer review is standard procedure. All new proposals and manuscripts considered for publication, whether Open Access or not, are presented to an independent editorial board. Following a positive response from the board, the full manuscript will be sent to two specialist readers for expert advice.
2. **Publishing expertise:** Leuven University Press has more than 45 years of experience, publishes in various formats (print books, eBooks, journals, etc.), and has acquired expertise in reaching out to a global academic audience.
3. **Partnership with OAPEN Library:** Leuven University Press has been granted access to OAPEN Library (www.oapen.org) and in this way offers a sustainable publication model that guarantees global impact, dissemination and digital preservation.





How to publish in OA with Leuven University Press?

Leuven University Press offers two different roads to Open Access.

The **green road** to Open Access, or so-called 'self-archiving', is the most accessible way to an OA publication. Authors of contributions, chapters, or articles are allowed to archive the pdf file of their contribution in the layout of the publication on their personal website immediately upon publication. *More details on our policy can be found on our website www.lup.be.*

In the **golden road** scenario the book appears in full Open Access from the first day of publication. The Open Access edition is made available via OAPEN Library. Besides this free online publication that can be downloaded, readers can also buy a paper edition. In this model financial means are needed to fund the production of the book.

Best practices

- *Glass Making in the Greco-Roman World: Results of the ARCHGLASS Project*, ISBN 9789461661579

Both books appeared in full Open Access from the first day of publication via OAPEN Library. Besides the free online edition, both volumes are also available in print. Both publications were funded by a European grant and have been downloaded in 84 countries worldwide.

Since 2014 Leuven University Press has also made a wide selection of titles published before 2000 freely available via Google Books.
