

SHOWER STEAMERS Basic Recipe 2022

Make 12 - 2 oz. shower steamers - lotus mold *Key **mix thoroughly** before adding wet ingredients to ensure even coloring.

- 8 oz Citric acid
- 16 oz Baking soda
- 2 oz White kaolin clay
- 1 oz Fragrance oil (combo essential oils and fragrance oils)
- .60 oz 91% rubbing alcohol
- .25 oz Polysorbate 80

1/2 tsp. Mica colorant

- 1. Add <u>baking soda, kaolin clay and mica</u> to the bowl. Using a wire whisk stir dry ingredients breaking up any clumps.
- 2. <u>Optional</u>: Sprinkle herbs (lavender buds, finely ground herbs spearmint, peppermint, etc.) in the cavity of each mold.
- 3. Mix together the rubbing alcohol, polysorbate 80 and fragrance oil.
- 4. <u>Pour this slowly</u> on to the dry mixture and immediately stir.
- 5. Add the <u>citric acid</u> and mix together thoroughly. (Mixture should hold together when squeezed.)

6. *Add a <u>6-8 spritz of rubbing alcohol</u> at a time to make sure the mixture is holding together when squeezed with hand and then dropping into the bowl.

7. Place plastic molds onto jelly roll pans. <u>Pack each cavity tightly</u> with the bath fizzy mixture. (Tip: <u>weigh mixture amount before</u> placing in molds if selling professionally.)

- 8. Let molds sit for at least <u>24 hours to dry.</u> Carefully pop out of mold.
- <u>9. Package</u> as desired <u>and label</u> accordingly.
- To Use: Place shower steamer/fizzy out of direct spray of the showerhead. Spray/drip water to release the scent. Vermont Lavender, LLC ©
