#### IMPORTANT - CMHC (GRANVILLE ISLAND PARKING)

Starting May 1, 2024, we will be making the following changes to pay parking on Granville Island:

- Pay parking will now be in effect from

- Weekend daytime rates will be increased by \$1/hour (no change to weekday daytime rates)
