What is the difference between PnP Rake wedges and other lob, sand or gap wedges?

The main difference: We have broken-up the one (1) large, blunt bounce, found on other wedges, into two (2) bounces; ie. a rail bounce and a secondary 'between rail' sole bounce.

Why does it work so well?

Sand and rough: The gap formed between the rail bounce and the lower sole bounce provides an avenue for the underlying sand and turf to pass through – thus more acceleration with less effort.

You will also have more control, as the rails assist to stabilise the club-head's intended direction through the sand and rough.

Tight lie and hardpan: The rail design breaks through the surface tension of the underlying surface, in effect lowering the club's leading edge at impact to deliver better contact and flight.




LOB - TURF/ROUGH SHOT



Plan view - Right hand

Slice through the turf or sand with club face, feet, hips and shoulders all open approx 5°-10°.

Club path to follow open stance.



Side view - Right hand

Hit down onto the back of the ball.


The off-set rail design with the on-set leading edge will get the ball uphigh and stop quickly due to the milled face.

SAND - BUNKER SHOT

Impact

1" to 2"

behind ball



Face on

Plan view - Right hand

Slice through sand with the club face, feet, hips and shoulders all open approx 10°-15°. Club path to follow

open stance.


Side view - Right hand

Hit down into the sand in a slicing action to let (25mm to 50mm) patented rails and central bounce work together.

The club will then comb through the sand, helping the ball in the air.

GAP - TURF

Steeper club



Plan view - Right hand

Assume your regular setup when addressing the ball.

Play your normal shortiron swing and make contact directly to the ball. Club path to follow

square stance.

NOTE: Both Lob and Sand Rakes can be used in each others role, however. each club is designed to give the optimum result in their specific role.
