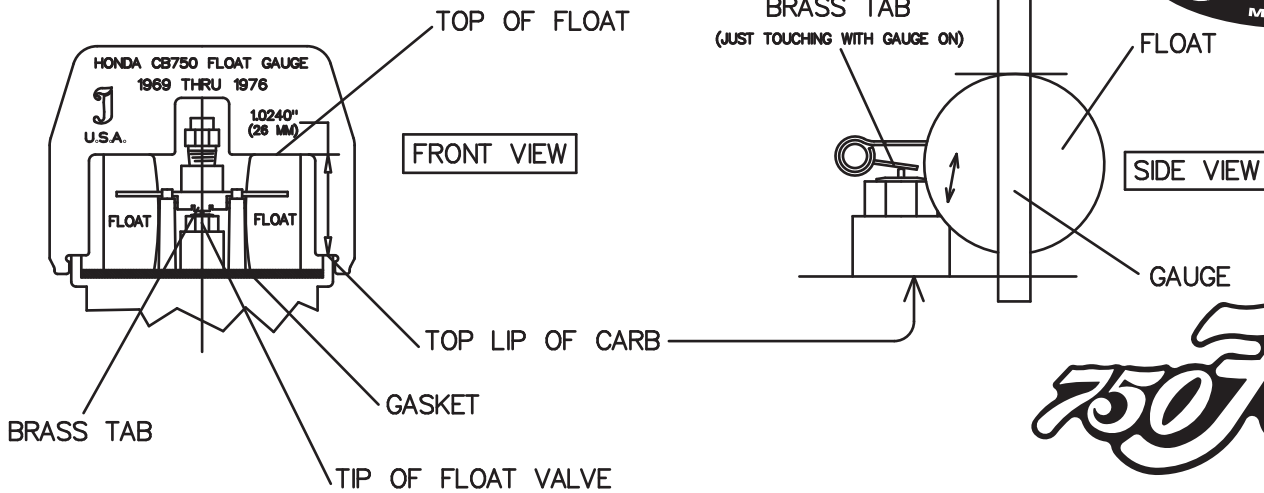


# Honda CB750 Carburetor Float Level Gauge

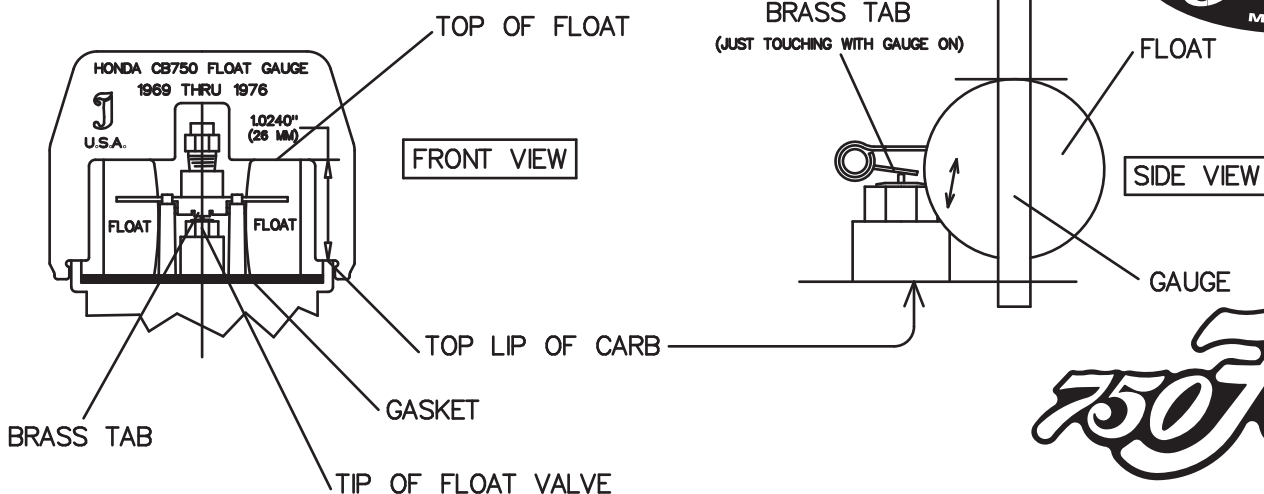
*750 Four*

1. Place the gauge over the floats and onto the upper "LIP" of the carburetor body
2. Take note of the small tip of the float valve
3. When the gauge is positioned, the brass tab should just barely touch the tip of the float valve without depressing it
4. If needed, bend the brass tab until it meets the requirements mentioned above
