Product Care

- * Exposure to certain chemicals or environments can result in compromising the pieces. This includes, but is not limited to the following: perspiration, perfume, cleaning agents, chlorine, saltwater, creams, chemicals and silver polish.
- * Platinum plated pieces will tarnish over time, but it will happen much faster when they come in contact with chemical agents such as perfume, salty air, sulphur, creams, hairspray, chlorine, and water/salty water. The amount of tarnish that may occur depends on the owners' care habits. Tarnishing is not a manufacturing fault, it is a natural process. To prevent tarnish and keep luster of pieces, products should be cleaned using a soft polishing cloth.
- * Gold plated pieces can be affected or damaged by chemicals, perfume, oil, moisture, soil, and creams. They should be cleaned in warm water and if needed use mild soap and a soft brush. Please dry thoroughly and use soft cloth. Stay away from cleaners and antibacterial soaps. When storing, pieces should be protected from scratches, chemicals and extreme temperatures.
