


Field of Flowers From Stripology Mixology 2 Adjustment to using Regular rulers

Make these cutting adjustments in the following steps:


Step 1: Cutting with regular rulers:


Use a pen and mark the bottom of the rectangle, 8-1/2" from the bottom left corner and mark the top of the rectangle 5-1/8" from the top left corner as shown. Align a ruler on the marked spots and cut apart.



Step 2: Lay your strip, **right** side up on your cutting mat. Align the 60° line on your ruler along the bottom of the strip and use the 6" marking on the ruler to cut 6" parallelograms from the strips.

Step 6: Use a pen and mark the bottom of the rectangle, 3-3/8" from the bottom left corner and mark the top of the rectangle 6-3/8" from the top left corner as shown. Align a ruler on the marked spots and cut apart.





Step 7: Lay your strip, **wrong** side up on your cutting mat. Align the 60° line on your ruler along the bottom of the strip and use the 6" marking on the ruler to cut 6" parallelograms from the strips.

Follow all other instructions for the quilt as stated in the book, such as trimming the blocks using the same measurements on a regular ruler as described with the Stripology ruler.



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
