

For a flying geese temperature quilt, you will use one flying geese block every day for 365 days. Each block represents the highest temperature of the day, and the lowest as well. Each day, you select two fabric colors that correspond to those "hotter" or "colder" temperatures. Once completed over the course of a year, your quilt will create a colorful map of temperature fluctuations in your area!

It's recommended that you use roughly 20 different colors in total to create a quilt with a clean gradient that isn't too busy. However, depending how intense your temperature fluctuations are, you can add more or fewer color blocks. We also recommend that you record any temperatures that are 5 degrees or more apart.
