# Strip Down <br> <br> Bonus Quilt 

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## Finisfing instructions

Since the project can be of various sizes, I can't give you fabric requirements. What you need depends on how many blocks you ended up with and which of the finishing layouts you choose.

## Option 1 <br> No sashing

You wont need any additional fabrics for this version, just arrange your blocks into rows, alternating the light and medium blocks. You could orient the blocks horizontal or vertical.


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## Option 2 Sashed Glocks

This version makes for a larger quilt. Depending on how many blocks you have, that will determine how much sashing fabric you need. You will need Two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles of sashing for each block. If you cut your sashing fabric into $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and sub cut into $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, you will get sixteen sashing rectangles out of a strip.


Add the sashing pieces to each side of the blocks and press outwards.

Your blocks should measure 8-1/2".

Arrange the blocks into horizontal rows, turning every other blocks as shown.

Finish the quilt with a 2-1/2" wide border to float the blocks.
