
## Strip Down Bonus Quilt


## Finishing instructions

Since the project can be of various sizes, I can't give you fabric requirements. What you need depends on how many blocks you ended up with and which of the finishing layouts you choose.

## Option 1 No sashing

You wont need any additional fabrics for this version, just arrange your blocks into rows, alternating the light and medium blocks. You could orient the blocks horizontal or vertical.







## Option 2 Sashed blocks

This version makes for a larger quilt. Depending on how many blocks you have, that will determine how much sashing fabric you need. You will need Two 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles of sashing for each block. If you cut your sashing fabric into 8-1/2" strips and sub cut into 8-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles, you will get







Add the sashing pieces to each side of the blocks and press outwards.

Your blocks should measure 8-1/2".

Arrange the blocks into horizontal rows, turning every other blocks as shown.

Finish the quilt with a 2-1/2" wide border to float the blocks.
