

HOW TO SET TIME AND DATE

- Unscrew and pull out the crown to the first click position
- Turn crown clockwise to set date
- Turn crown counter clockwise to adjust GMT hand
- 4. Pull out the crown to second click position
- Turn the crown to move hour, GMT and minute hand
 Bemember to securely screw in the crown.
 - You do so by placing the crown at first click position and then push the crown towards the watch while screwing it clockwise until it's 100% tight.

If this is not done correctly you risk that moist and dust will enter your watch!

HOW TO USE THE SECOND TIMEZONE

- 1. Turn the bezel to the get desired time difference at the 12H position
- 2. Use the GMT hand as the hour hand
