Reading Issues

- has difficulty reading common sight words like “because” or simple words like “thin” or “sleek.”

Spelling and Writing Issues

Developmental Issues

- has difficulty recalling jokes and stories.
- performs inconsistently on academic tasks from day-to-day. One day, they accurately spell “before,” but the next day, they’ve forgotten.
- has a teacher who suggests you hold them back.
