



Instructions For Mixing And Applying Single Process Hair Color

Mixing Your Color Formula

Each tube of color has measurement lines. Squeeze the tube to the measurement line necessary for the amount you will need for touching up your roots. A good guide is if you have fine/thin to normal hair then mix 2 ounces of color and 2 ounces of developer. If you have very dense thick hair add 1/2 ounce more of both color and developer. You can always mix more if you run out, rather than overmixing product.

Squeeze tube from the wide end (opposite cap) following the measurements indicated on the side of the tube.

For a single color application mix:

- 2 oz. Color
- 2 oz. Peroxide* - This amount is good for average hair thickness. You may need to adjust the quantity.

* Always add equal parts of color and developer (i.e., 2 oz. color and 2 oz. developer)

Directions:

- Add color to bowl then add developer
- Mix well until smooth
- Apply to roots and leave on 35min
- Rinse hair well then shampoo and condition as usual
