MEASUREMENT CHART

INSTRUCTIONS

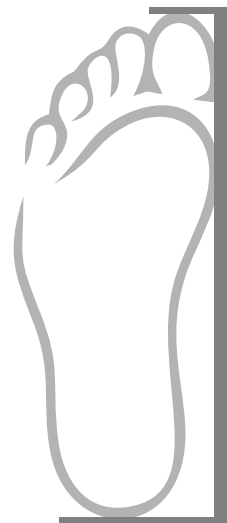
1. Check that your printer is set to 100% printing scale, otherwise the sizing will not be accurate.
2. Print out the sizing chart.
3. Place the chart on a hard floor.
4. Ask your child to stand on the printed paper ensuring the foot and toes are sitting straight on the paper and that the foot is on the heel line.
5. Measure one foot at a time, marking on the paper the point of the longest toe. Measure both feet as one foot may be longer than the other.
6. **Always choose the largest foot size for purchasing.**

Where the toes fall, the correct shoe size is the corresponding number on the left.

Sizing allows for the correct space at the end of the shoe.

To ensure the scale is accurate, please check that this box is the same size as a credit card.
