



## Nashdale Lane Wines 2018 Shiraz

### Vineyard

Elevation : 890m above sea level.

Soils : fine silt, minimal red basalt

Harvested : 25<sup>th</sup> Mch 2018

Clone: PT23 & 1654

Oak: New and old French Oak (30% new) – 14 months

### Winery

Crushed to small, open fermenters the 2018 Nashdale Lane Shiraz was cold soaked to gain more colour and flavour prior to fermentation.

Daily plunging by hand and occasional delestage.

The ferment was allowed to get hot towards the end for maximum extraction of natural colour, flavours and tannins. Pressed to barrel a selection of new and old French oak from different coopers was used. Approximately 30% new oak.

### Taste

Colour : Deep ruby

Nose : Lifted varietal spice and red berry fruit, raspberries

On the palate Silky oak tannins, vanilla, red fruits and spice

Alcohol: 13.5% / 8.04 standard drinks

### Ageing potential

5- 7 years
