#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

RS - right side WS - wrong side

k - knit p - purl

st(s) - stitch(es)

yo - yarn over

same stitch

cdd - central double decrease - Slip two stitches together knit wise. Knit one stitch. Pass both slipped stitches over the knit stitch.

ssk - slip 2 stitches knitwise, knit these 2 stitches together through back loops ..

k2tog - knit 2 stitches together p2tog - purl 2 stitches together

kfb - knit into the front and then the back of the k2tog tbl - knit 2 stitches together through back loop p2tog tbl - purl 2 stitches together through back loop

#### **COLOUR ORDER**

The sample shown is based on the colours of Hedgehog Fibres 2023 Advent Calendar.

I used the following order of the Minis skeins: 14, 3, 18, 15, 7, 17, 4, 20, 13, 10, 16, 2, 21, 1, 9, 12, 6, 24, 5, 22

You are welcome to experiment and don't be afraid to come up with your own sequence. Knitter's choice!

| YARN            | 400g of Hedgehog Fibres Sock Yarn Minis (90% Merino wool, 10% nylon, 20g/80m) in a variety of colours or scraps. Yarn held double throughout the project.                    |

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# INSTRUCTIONS

The marled effect is achieved by starting with two strands of Colour A, then you will drop one strand of A and replace it with one strand of B. As you are running out of A, two strands of Colour B, and then B and C and so on. There is no striping with this technique and marling creates a softer transition. You can change your colours at will in blocks that you find visually pleasing or as you are running out of your minis. Marling creates soft transitions and cool new colour combinations that might surprise you!

Try laying out your Minis out first and find a combination that you love. And take a photo of it just in case! The colours shown are all part of Hedgehog Fibres 2023 Advent Calendar.

## **Cast on 3 stitches**

### Setup:

Row 1 (WS): k Row 2 (RS): kfb, k to last st., kfb Row 3 (WS): k Repeat Rows 2 and 3 three more times (11 stitches)

#### **Care Notes**

Whether you are using commercially dyed yarn or lovely hand-dyed skeins, please keep in mind that colours might bleed. None of the examples shown bled, but I always knit up a sample and wash it as you would your finished item to be sure. Please use common sense - reds and crazy pinks tend to bleed the most, any red/white combo is probably not a good idea (we separate laundry, right?). To minimise bleeding, gently soak the swatch/finished item in cold water with a mild detergent or wool wash. The gentler you wash your project the better it will look over time.
