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# POLLINATION

For everyone who wants to indulge in a bit of mindless knitting, this is a lovely large scarf in a slanted rib reversible pattern. Only knit and purl stitches!  
Knitted flat and finished off with four large tassels.

#### YARN

Merino Aran by Hedgehog Fibres: 4 skeins. Pictured in 'Pollen' colourway.  
Yardage includes the tassels.

#### NEEDLE

5mm pair of needles. The scarf is knitted flat.

#### GAUGE

Not too important. My scarf used approx. 450m/390g, using the recommended yarn and needle size. The yardage may vary.

#### FINISHED SIZE

30cm wide and 170cm long, after light blocking. Excluding tassels.

### CHART NOTES

This project is knitted flat, you'll knit back and forth, turning your work each time you finish a row. The numbered rows alternate between the left and right hand sides of the chart. This indicates that you would begin with row 1, reading it from right to left. When you finish row 1 and turn your work to begin row 2, you begin from the left side of the chart where the number "2" is. You will also find that the key for the stitches is worked differently at this point as well. Since you will be working on both sides of the knitting, a symbol on the chart may have a different meaning depending on which row you are completing - see the key.

### INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 54 stitches, using long tail or other preferred cast on method.  
Slip all first stitches.

Follow the chart, starting with Row 1, repeating the pink section 6 times for each row.  
Repeat the chart until desired length is achieved.

For a narrower scarf, cast on 8 stitches less (46) and repeat the pink section 5 times for each row.  
For a wider scarf, cast on 8 more stitches (62) and repeat the pink section 7 times for each row.

Cast off loosely, using a Sewn cast off or other stretchy cast off. There are many tutorials on the internet.  
Block lightly to even out the stripes.
