

Simple, big, thick and snuggly cowl. Featuring a staggered rib reversible pattern that is quick to knit and fun to wear. Skills needed: German twisted or long tail cast on and sewn cast off.

Knit in the round.

YARN

As pictured:

Hedgehog Fibres, Merino Aran, 166m/100g, 2 skeins - colourway Concrete

The cowl took <u>exactly</u> 2 skeins, for a peace of mind buy 3 skeins, but if you are daring or willing to sacrifice one or two rounds, buy only two!

NEEDLE

5mm, 24" or longer circular needle.

GAUGE

18 stitches by 27 rows to 10cm in stockinette, using the specified Merino Aran. Measurement taken from relaxed fabric after wet-blocking. Gauge not hugely important.

ADDITIONAL TOOLS

blunt tapestry needle, 1 stitch marker

DIRECTIONS

Cast on 234 stitches using a German Twisted or Long Tail cast on. Join in the round and place a marker at the beginning of the round.

Start at row 1 of thr chart and follow the chart. Empty square is a knit stitch, dash is a purl stitch. Remember, the right side of your knitting is always facing you, so follow all rows of the chart right to left. The chart shows one repeat of the pattern, repeat 13 times across work.

Repeat rows 1-16, 3 times.

Cast off using Sewn cast off or another stretchy cast off, if you prefer.
