



PIKLER TRIANGLE SAFETY

THANK YOU FOR PURCHASING A PIKLER TRIANGLE AND RAMP. THE FOLLOWING ARE SOME GUIDELINES TO KEEP YOUR NEW PURCHASE SHINY AND YOUR LITTLE BIG USERS AS SAFE AS POSSIBLE WHILE THEY PRETEND TO BE MOUNTAIN CLIMBERS.



- Pikler Triangles are only be used upon flat level and firm (but not hard) surfaces. Thin rugs and firm carpets are suitable.

- Please ensure close adult supervision at all times. Do not place Little Big people into positions they cannot get into themselves. The purpose and theory behind the Pikler Triangle is that children will discover it in their own time and respect their own physical limits. We need to respect those limits too.

- Pikler Triangle Rock Wall & Slides are designed to be placed on an angle of no more than 60 degrees. If your Little Big climber is ready for vertical climbing, please consider if a Little Big Rock Climbing Tree is more appropriate (coming soon!). Ramps should be moved from rung to rung by adults only.

- Pikler Triangles and birch ramps are sold raw which means you have an endless list of possible finishes to choose from! To protect the wood, we recommend oiling, painting or varnishing regularly.

- As with all children's products, it is recommended that you check your Triangle regularly (as often as every use) for structural stability. NB: all products are intended for use by young children only.

- Little Big Pikler Triangles come with a 2 year structural warranty. This does not include natural wear and tear or any damages caused by misuse or incorrect assembly.
