


### **TOOLS REQUIRED**

## SPIRAL TUBE SLIDE ASSEMBLY

Before starting to assemble your Spiral Tube Slide, familiarize yourself with the contents. Identify each component and hardware listed on Page 2. Hardware is shown actual size.

#### Items for <u>STEP 1</u>: Crow's Nest Assembly


- (2) Side Walls
- (1) Floor
- 5/16" x 1" hex bolts
- (12) 5/16" washers
- 5/16" lock nuts


Position the side walls and floor as shown. (Fig. 1)

Note: The compression flanges of all three parts must be facing up as shown.

Attach the side walls to the floor using 5/16" x 1" hex bolts, 5/16" washers and 5/16" lock nuts as shown. (Fig. 1)

Tighten firmly with a 1/2" socket and wrench but do not over tighten.







#### Items for STEP 2:


- (1) Top Bar
- (4) 5/16" x 1" hex bolts
- (8) 5/16" washers
- (4) 5/16" lock nuts

Attach the top bar to the side walls using 5/16" x 1" hex bolts, 5/16" washers and 5/16" lock nuts as shown.

Tighten firmly with a 1/2" socket and wrench but do not over tighten.







#### Items for STEP 3:

- (1) Crow's Nest Assembly
- (18) #14 x 11/4" pan head screws


Position <u>Crow's Nest</u> Assembly into the playset opening.


(Refer to your original PlayStar Safety Guidelines and Building Instructions for complete playset construction details.)

Make sure the <u>Crow's Nest</u> Assembly is fully inserted, and all three flanges are firmly resting against the lumber. Mark holes with a pencil.

At each marked location, drill  $\frac{1}{8}$ " holes 1" deep into the boards.

Secure assembly with #14 x  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " pan head screws as shown.







#### Items for <u>STEP 4</u>: Entrance Assembly

- (1) Left Entrance Section
- (1) Right Entrance Section
- (6) 5/16" x 3/4" hex bolts
- (12) 5/16" washers
- (6) 5/16" lock nuts

Attach the two entrance sections using  $\frac{5}{16}$ " x  $\frac{3}{4}$ " hex bolts,  $\frac{5}{16}$ " washers and  $\frac{5}{16}$ " lock nuts as shown.

Finger tighten only at this time.




#### Items for <u>STEP 5</u>: 60° Tunnel Assembly

- (8) 60° halves
- (28) 5/16" x 3/4" hex bolts
- (56) 5/16" washers
- (28) 5/16" lock nuts

Attach two 60° halves using  $\frac{5}{16}$ " x  $\frac{3}{4}$ " hex bolts,  $\frac{5}{16}$ " washers and  $\frac{5}{16}$ " lock nuts as shown.

Finger tighten only at this time.

Repeat this assembly four times.




#### Items for STEP 6:

60° Exit Assembly

- (1) 60° half
- (1) Exit Top
- (7) 5/16" x 3/4" hex bolts
- (14) 5/16" washers
- (7) 5/16" lock nuts

Attach 60° half to the exit top using  $\frac{5}{6}$ " x  $\frac{3}{4}$ " hex bolts,  $\frac{5}{6}$ " washers and  $\frac{5}{6}$ " lock nuts as shown.

Finger tighten only at this time.




#### Items for STEP 7:

- (1) Entrance Assembly
- (1) 60° Tunnel Assembly
- (14) 5/16" x 3/4" hex bolts
- (28) 5/16" washers
- (14) 5/16" lock nuts

Attach one  $60^{\circ}$  Tunnel Assembly to the Entrance Assembly using  $\frac{5}{16}$ " x  $\frac{3}{4}$ " hex bolts,  $\frac{5}{16}$ " washers and  $\frac{5}{16}$ " lock nuts as shown.

Finger tighten only at this time.

Note: The long flange on the 60° Tunnel Assembly will be rotated clockwise, with three bolts between the two long flanges.



Note: If the circular flanges along the <u>Entrance Assembly</u> are not straight due to packaging or shipping, place components in direct sun and or use a household hair dryer to soften flanges. Then bend straight using your hands.

Assembly Tip: If lining up holes is difficult, loosen bolts on the long flange of each component to give more clearance.

#### Items for STEP 8:

- (3) 60° Tunnel Assemblies
- (42) 5/16" x 3/4" hex bolts
- (84) 5/16" washers
- (42) 5/16" lock nuts

Attach <u>60° Tunnel Assembly</u> using  $\frac{5}{16}$ " x  $\frac{3}{4}$ " hex bolts,  $\frac{5}{16}$ " washers and  $\frac{5}{16}$ " lock nuts as shown.


Finger tighten only at this time.


Note: The long flange on the 60° Tunnel

<u>Assemblies</u> will be rotated counter-clockwise with only one bolt between the two

long flanges.

Repeat for each Additional 60° Tunnel Assembly.






#### Items for STEP 9:


- (1) 60° Exit Assembly
- (14) 5/16" x 3/4" hex bolts
- (28) 5/16" washers
- (14) 5/16" lock nuts

Attach the <u>60° Exit Assembly</u> using  $\frac{5}{16}$ " x  $\frac{3}{4}$ " hex bolts,  $\frac{5}{16}$ " washers and  $\frac{5}{16}$ " lock nuts as shown.

Finger tighten only at this time.

Note: The long flange on the 60° Exit Assembly will be rotated counter-clockwise with only one bolt between the two









- (1) Exit
- (8) 5/16" x 3/4" hex bolts
- (16) 5/16" washers
- (8) 5/16" lock nuts

Attach the Exit using 5/16" x 3/4" hex bolts,



At this time use a 1/2" socket and wrench to tighten all the nuts and bolts that have been finger tightened in Steps 4 through 10 while making sure flanges are relatively flush with each other.

**DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN!**

#### Items for STEP 12:

- (8) 5/16" x 3/4" stove bolts
- (8) 5/16" washers
- (8) 5/16" lock nuts

Lift the assembly to the upright position and insert the entrance end into the Crow's Nest Assembly.


This requires two adults.


Attach at top and bottom using  $\frac{5}{16}$ " x  $\frac{3}{4}$ " stove bolts,  $\frac{5}{16}$ " washers and  $\frac{5}{16}$ " lock nuts as shown.

Tighten firmly but do not over tighten.

Note: The pan head of the stove bolts must be on the inside and lock nuts on the outside as shown.

Note: Make sure the exit is resting firmly in hole dug in previous step.






#### Items for STEP 13:

- (10) 5/16" x 3/4" hex bolts
- (20) 5/16" washers
- (10) 5/16" lock nuts

Attach the sides using 5/16" x 3/4" hex bolts, 5/16" washers and 5/16" lock nuts as shown.




#### Items for STEP 14:

- (2) 2" x 4" x 241/4" boards
- (4) #8 x 21/2" deck screws

On a flat work surface place the 2"  $\times$  4"  $\times$  241/4" boards to form an "L" as shown. Make sure the ends are flush on both sides.

Drill an  $\frac{1}{8}$ " hole at locations shown. Secure with  $\frac{48 \times 21}{2}$ " deck screws.




#### Items for STEP 15:


- (1) Step 14 Assembly
- (2) 2" x 4" x 195%" boards
- (8) #8 x 21/2" deck screws

Lay the <u>Step 14</u> Assembly on the ground under the slide exit as shown.

Insert one 2" x 4" x 195%" into each of the exit pockets as shown. Make sure both sides are flush with the <u>Step 14</u> Assembly laying on the ground.

Drill an  $\frac{1}{8}$ " hole at locations shown. Secure each 2" x 4" x  $\frac{195}{8}$ " to the Step 14 Assembly with  $\frac{8}{8}$  x  $\frac{21}{2}$ " deck screws as shown.






#### Items for STEP 16:

(4) #14 x 11/4" pan head screws

Make sure the 2" x 4" x 195%" boards are vertical and the exit pockets are firmly resting on top of them. Using the exit pocket holes as pattern, drill 1%" holes 1" deep into the boards.

Note: Be careful not to drill deeper than 1" or the exit could be damaged.

Attach with #14 x 11/4" pan head screws on each pocket as shown.



#### Items for STEP 17:

- (2) Anchors
- (2) 3/8" x 2" lag screws
- (2) 3/8" washers

Make sure the exit is level and making firm contact with the ground.


Note: If the exit is not making contact with the ground, it will be necessary to remove earth under the lumber support until exit firmly contacts the ground.


At locations shown screw Playset Anchors into ground by hand (a long screwdriver will help).

Use the anchor mounting hole as a drill guide and drill a 1/4" hole 11/2" deep into the boards. Attach with 3/6" x 2" lag screws and 3/6" washers provided.

Fill in around bottom of slide exit to make surface level with surrounding grade.

Note: If soil conditions permit anchors to be pulled out easily, such as in sandy soil conditions, cementing is required. Anchors must be placed below the level of shock-absorbing material to prevent tripping or injury resulting from a fall.


If your playset is Build it Yourself, proceed to page 17.

#### Items for <u>STEP 18-RTA</u>:

- (1) Support Bracket
- (1) 2" x 4" x 91/2" board
- (4) #8 x 11/4" deck screws

Align the top edge and the second slot of the support bracket with the top and end of the 2" x 4" x 9½" board as shown.


Use the bracket as template and drill 1/8" holes 1" deep. Secure with #8 x 11/4" deck screws.



#### Items for STEP 19-RTA:

- (1) 3/8" x 2" hex bolt
- (2) 3/8" washers
- (1) 3/8" lock nut

Drill a %" hole through the 2" x 4" x 9½" board. Attach with %" x 2" hex bolt, %" washers and %" lock nut as shown.




#### Items for STEP 20-RTA:

- (1) Support Bracket Assembly
- (1) 5/16" x 1" hex bolt

Locate the second bolt from the top on the 60° Exit Assembly as shown. Remove and discard the bolt, save the nut and the washers.

Attach the Support Bracket Assembly to the slide using a 5/16" x 1" hex bolt and the washers and nut saved previously through the hole in the middle of the bracket flange as shown.

Tighten firmly but do not over tighten.



#### Items for <u>STEP 21-RTA</u>:


- (1) 3/8" x 31/2" hex bolt
- (2) 3/8" washers
- (1) 3/8" lock nut
- (4) #8 x 21/2" deck screws

Attach Support Bracket Assembly to the 2" x 4" x 88" board keeping it level as shown.

Make sure the Support Bracket Assembly does not torque or twist the tube slide when in contact with the 2" x 4" x 88" board.

Secure with #8 x 21/2" deck screws.

Drill a %" hole at the center of the deck screws through the boards. Secure with %" x 3½" hex bolt, %" washers and %" lock nut as shown.



Note: Inspect all fasteners before children are allowed to play on the Spiral Tube Slide



#### Items for STEP 18-BIY:

- (1) Support Bracket
- (1) 2" x 4" x 91/2" board
- (4) #8 x 11/4" deck screws

Align the top edge and the first slot of the support bracket with the top and end of the 2" x 4" x 9½" board as shown.


Use the bracket as template and drill 1/8" holes 1" deep. Secure with #8 x 11/4" deck screws.



#### Items for STEP 19-BIY:

- (1) 3/8" x 2" hex bolt
- (2) 3/8" washers
- (1) %" lock nut

Drill a %" hole through the 2" x 4" x 9½" board. Attach with %" x 2" hex bolt, %" washers and %" lock nut as shown.




#### Items for STEP 20-BIY:

- (1) Support Bracket Assembly
- (1) 5/16" x 1" hex bolt

Locate the first bolt from the top on the 60° Exit Assembly as shown. Remove and discard the bolt, save the nut and the washers.

Attach the Support Bracket Assembly to the slide using a  $\frac{5}{10}$ " x 1" hex bolt and the washers and nut saved previously through the hole in the far end of the bracket flange as shown.

Tighten firmly but do not over tighten.



#### Items for <u>STEP 21-BIY</u>:


- (1) 3/8" x 31/2" hex bolt
- (2) 3/8" washers
- (1) 3/8" lock nut
- (4) #8 x 21/2" deck screws

Attach Support Bracket Assembly to the 2" x 4" x 112" board keeping it level as shown.

Make sure the Support Bracket Assembly does not torque or twist the tube slide when in contact with the 2" x 4" x 112" board.

Secure with #8 x 2½" deck screws.

Drill a %" hole at the center of the deck screws through the boards. Secure with %" x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " hex bolt, %" washers and %" lock nut as shown.
