

TOOLS NEEDED FOR ASSEMBLY

Tools to assemble the mudguards are provided. An 8mm spanner (for the nuts) and a 3mm Allen key (for the hex bolts) is provided. You will need a 15mm spanner for the wheel nuts, the wheel tool that comes with your scooter is ideal.

Prepare your scooter by disconnecting the brakes and removing both wheels.

Assemble Wire Stays, rear Mudguard Flap and Flap Support to the correct Mudguards as shown in the diagram. Use 12mm Bolts, Nuts and Flat Washers as shown. Tighten fully.

Attach front mudguard and wire stay to the front fork.

Secure rear mudguard to the end of frame with 12mm Bolt, Split Washer, and Flat Washer. Tighten fully.

Secure rear wire stays to the rear dropout with 20mm Bolts, Nuts, and 2 × Flat Washers. Tighten fully.
