Controls



- Power ON / Power OFF
- 2 Enter Pairing Mode / Answer Call
- 3 Volume Down
- 4 Play / Pause
- 5 Volume Up
- 6 Charging Port
- AUX Port

Pairing

- Hold the power button for 3 seconds to turn the speaker on
- Hold the pairing button until you hear "Pairing"
- 3 Find "Back Bay Newbury" in your device's Bluetooth settings

If a PIN code is required, use "0000" or "1234"



After you've connected once, your device will recognize your speaker when you turn it on again!

Connect 2 Newbury Speakers

- Make sure neither speaker is connected to a device
- 2 Hold the power button to turn on speaker 1
- 3 Press and hold the pairing button to disconnect from your device and enter pairing mode
- Turn on speaker 2 and place it within 10 feet of speaker 1
- Wait until you hear "Stereo Connected" then find "Back Bay Newbury" in your device's Bluetooth menu

If you are having trouble getting the speakers to connect to each other, go into your device's Bluetooth settings, find "Back Bay Newbury" and click "Forget" or "Unpair," then follow the instructions again.

Aux Mode

To play music through a 3.5 mm aux cable, just power on the speaker and insert the aux cable into the aux port.

Charging

Locate the micro USB cable included in the packaging. Plug it into the speaker's usb port and connect the cable to a power source.

Red Light = Charging No Light = Fully Charged
