



**RIGHT NOW IS THE PERFECT TIME** to hit refresh on your routine. A fun place to start?

Your makeup bag. But there's no need to do a full overhaul. Instead, pair your staples (like foundation and concealer) with a few newbies that will help you score done-but-not-too-done looks—think stained lips and gorgeously flushed cheeks. Here, the ideas you've got to try for spring, and how to master them.

## 1/ GOLDEN GLIMMERS

The easiest way to perk up tired skin? Highlighter. Thankfully, the latest formulas won't make you look like a unicorn. "Gold works on all skin tones and helps warm up your face," explains Neil Scibelli, a makeup artist in New York City. For an allover glow, mix a drop of cream like (1) Rimmel London Insta Strobing 2-in-1 Highlighter in Gold Glow (\$7; at drugstores) with your base before applying. Or target your cheekbones, the bridge of your nose, and your cupid's bow by sweeping a powder on those spots. Save with (2) Maybelline New York Master Chrome in Molten Gold (\$8; target.com), and splurge on (3) Anastasia Amrezy Highlighter (\$28; anastasiabeverlyhills.com). If you have a dark complexion, opt for Cosmetics by Diggle.

## 2/ PEACH FLUSH

If you've been a loyal pink blush wearer for years, it's time to make the switch. Think of peach as pink's hotter cousin. In addition to giving you a subtle, sun-kissed glow, it also has a hidden skin-care benefit: "I always opt for a peach blush on clients, because the yellow undertones in it counteract any redness," says Scibelli. (5) Troy Surratt Artistique Blush in Peau de Peche (\$32; sephora.com) has a satin finish, making it the perfect choice to help balance oily skin types. Justine Purdue, a celebrity makeup artist for Streeters in New York City, is a fan of cream blush like (6) Touch in Sol Dixi Chicxi Glossy in #3 Vivid Orange (\$20; touchinsol-us.com), because it sinks into skin, mimicking your natural flush. Just tap it along cheekbones, then blend with fingers or a damp sponge. For a pop of color with shimmery golden flecks, try (7) It Cosmetics Bye Bye Pores Blush (\$24; itcosmetics.com), which helps blur the appearance of pores.



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
