Flights or Tastings: 1.5 oz of any 4 wines or 1 oz of any 6 wines.....\$10

Alma: Named after our mother, this delicate, dry 2018 **Viognier** varietal wine is bright, fruit forward, with hints of stone fruits and floral notes, was aged in stainless steel, no oak, for about 6 months. **Silver medal winner in the 2019 Loudoun Wine Awards**.....\$25

Stephen: Named after our grandfather, oldest son, and youngest grandson, this dry 2018 varietal **Sauvignon Blanc** is crisp, fruit forward, with citrus and grassy notes, was aged in stainless steel, no oak, for about 6 months and is a favorite warm weather wine.....\$25

Patricia: Named after our mother-in-law, this dry, fruit forward, crisp 2018 **Petit Manseng** white wine was fermented and aged in stainless steel, no oak, for about 5 months and expresses tropical fruits, especially citrus. **Silver medal winner in the 2020 Virginia Governor's Cup Competition**.....\$25

Lisa & Thad SO: Named after our daughter and son-in-law, this dry 2017 **Petit Manseng** varietal wine was aged in steel and French oak for 18 months, expresses citrus and pineapple fruits, and mild oak tannins.....\$25

Harle Rose: Named after our street in Leesburg, this dry 2019 **Rose** was blended at a neighborhood party, is dark pink, expresses cherry and strawberry notes, and combines **Sauvignon Blanc** and **Cabernet Franc**, the oenological parents of Cabernet Sauvignon.....\$25

Duke: Named after a dear friend of our family, this dry 2018 **Cabernet Franc** was aged in new and neutral French oak for about 12 months, is ruby red, and expresses bright red fruit, mild oak and fruit tannins, and characteristic pepper on a smooth finish.....\$30

Charles: Named after two uncles, a first cousin, and two puppies (Charlie), is our 2018 varietal **Merlot**. It was aged in new and neutral French oak for about 12 months and expresses red fruits, mild tannins, and a smooth finish.....\$30

La Famiglia (2018): Named for our family, this dry, fruit forward, Bordeaux style blend of **Merlot** and **Cabernet Franc** was aged in new and neutral French oak barrels for about 12 months and expresses a smoothness on the pallet, bright red fruits, and mild tannins.....\$30

2nd Act: Named for this family venture, this dry, fruit forward, Bordeaux style blend of **Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot & a touch of Petit Verdot**, was aged in neutral and new French oak for about 12 months, is dark red, and expresses red fruits, mild tannins, and a smooth finish. **Silver medal winner in the 2020 Virginia Governor's Cup**.....\$35
