The Beach Ball Pillow is a near-spherical pillow composed of six equal segments (gores). This pattern will make an 8 ", 12 ", or 16 " diameter ball pillow.

Medium-weight drapery fabrics work best. Interlining or fusible stabilizer is recommended for lightweight fabrics. Solid fabrics are best, however creative designs can be achieved using stripes and plaid fabrics or alternating different fabrics in one pillow.

## YARDAGE

Yardage estimates are based on 54 " wide solid fabrics. More fabric may be required depending on the pattern repeat and design placement. More fill may be needed to achieve desired firmness.

## 8" ball pillow

1/2 yard on bias or straight grain stuff with 8 oz polyester fill (similar to a 12" square pillow)

## 12" ball pillow

3/4 yard on bias, 2/3 yard on straight of grain
stuff with 24 oz polyester fill (similar to a 22 " square pillow)

## 16" ball pillow

1 yard on bias, 3/4 yard on straight of grain
stuff with 48 oz polyester fill (similar to a 28 " square pillow)
