Swag sections have fullness only on the bottom. Jabots and tails are cut for flare at the top. Instructions are included for construction of board and applying rope.

One **swag can extend 16" - 34" wide**. Use as many swag sections as your window may need. Swag depths are **18"-24"** without having to alter the pattern. The **tail depth is 18" or 22"**. The **jabot finishes 38" to 44"** deep. Alteration instructions are included for making it deeper.

Fabric Suggestions: Chintz, linen, damask, most any drapery fabric. Make sure fabric will adapt well to gathers. Use a cord or rope (with lip) for the top of the tail and jabot so their tops will have more flare. A rope (no lip) trim is used 4" or 5" down from the top of the board. The tails and jabots need a self or contrast lining. Swag sections can be lined with a regular drapery lining.

YARDAGE

Decide how many swag sections you need for your window. Stay within a 16" to 34" width range.

With so many different fabric widths and repeats available today, we find it works best if we give you the actual pattern sizes so you can determine how they will fit on your fabric.

18" and 20" SWAG DEPTH

Swag..... the pattern is your size, plus 4" wide x 32" deep
 Return..... the pattern is 9" wide x 32" deep
 Tail..... the pattern is 28" wide x 19" deep
 Jabot..... the pattern is 33" wide x 40" deep

22" and 24" SWAG DEPTH

Swag..... the pattern is your size, plus 4" wide x 35" deep
 Return..... the pattern is 9" wide x 35" deep
 Tail..... the pattern is 32" wide x 23" deep
 Jabot..... the pattern is 33" wide x 44" deep

Same amount of lining will be needed.

Double cord shirr tape: (such as Conso® # 10822) 44" will be sufficient for one swag section. Add 22" for each, additional swag added. Also add 22" for each return.

Rope: (no lip) Tying a double knot works best. Use a rope of about 1/2" diameter. Figure width of board, plus returns, and 13" for each knot.

Yardage for trims (bottom edge only)	Each swag.....your width, plus 4"
Trims must be able to curve.	Each return.....9"
	Each tail.....38"
	Each jabot.....43"
