Butterfly Swag 9105

This design consists of two swag sections that must be cut as a pair. They are joined together with a shirred seam in the middle. The mount board, (patterns and instructions are also included), has a 5" arch, upward, at the center. **The swag depth is about 20"** at the deepest area (does not include trim). Minor adjustments can be made to the depth by pulling up or down on the middle shirr tape. **The board and swag width is 48" to 54"** without having to do alterations. This measurement is taken straight across the board "face". **The jabot finishes 61/2" wide and 46" deep.** You have a choice between the pleated tail or the traditional horn, to cover the swag seam. The beautiful scalloped rosette is optional. It finishes about 6" and has a tassel chair tie, knotted and hanging from its center. It is not recommended you alter any of the pattern pieces but suggestions are included to help you accommodate board widths of 45" and up to 70".

Fabric Suggestions: Soft fabrics work best. Bulky fabrics can be a problem with pleat stack up. Striped fabric is acceptable but may, or may not, be pleasing to you on the tail section. The jabots, tail, horn and rosette should be self or contrast lined. The swags can be lined with a regular drapery lining. Interlining can be used and information is given to help control interlining and lining bulk. A 27" tassel chair tie is needed for the rosette.

YARDAGE

With so many different fabric widths and repeats available today, we find it works best if we give you the actual pattern sizes so you can determine how they will fit on your fabric.

Each swag (two cuts are needed)	(upright cut) 39" wide x 40"
	(bias cut) 39" wide x 49"
Horn the pattern is	14" wide x 19"
Tail the pattern is	25" wide x 21"
Jabot the pattern is	44" wide x 48"
Rosette one circle each	8",7",6"
Shirring tape 34" will be needed for	the swag (Example, Conso® 10819 or

Same amount of lining will be needed.

Yardage for trims:

Trims must be able to curve.

Each swag 43" Horn 15" *Tail 43" Each jabot 55"

*The tail has a very wide bottom spread, it is best to use a short simple trim, or no trim. The horn is best suited for deep trims.
