Kingston Pole Swag

This revised 2007 edition has all new instructions for an easier construction!

This pole swag may be pleated or gathered. It can be seamless (if the fabric allows). **Swag width extend 14" to 28".** The patterns have cutting lines for **18"**, **20" or 22" swag depths**. (These measurements are from the top of a 2" pole). The swags have an open "droop" area of 3" from the bottom of a 2" pole. The swags may be cut bias, upright, or lengthwise. Use the jabot or the simple return. **The jabot finishes about 36"**, **39"**, **or 43"**. Use the standard horn or the double folded horn.

The fullness area and the droop area can be altered. There are no alteration instructions included for the swag width or depth.

Fabric Suggestions: Soft fabrics and fabrics that lend themselves well to holding pleats. Stay away from extremely bulky fabrics. The bottom cut of the pattern is straight, (including the jabot) which makes it work wonderfully for fabrics with borders that need to be railroaded. Wide braid or trim can easily be added to the bottom edge. They do not have to curve. When finished, the horn sections flare out, exposing a little of the lining. You may want to plan a self or contrast lining for them and for the returns or jabots. A regular drapery lining should be used for the swag sections

YARDAGE

To know how many swag sections to use, subtract 3" from the finished width, then divide into equal units. Stay within a 14" to 28" width range.

You will need a *pair* of returns or a pair of jabots. You need a horn between each swag. You will need a horn between a swag and a return You will need a horn between a swag and a jabot.

With so many different fabric widths and repeats available today, we find it works best if we give you the actual pattern sizes so you can determine how they will fit on your fabric.

Lengthwise cut (railroad), add together the trim measurements of the pieces you need. This will be the length of fabric at the selvage x 35" (18" depth), 37" (20" depth), or 39" (22" depth). See page 15 if confused.
