



Fun Pillows

The Basketball and Football Pillows have seams that contain fullness that must be eased in. This is done by pressing, and is best achieved with fabrics that are *not* 100% cotton. A blend that has some man-made fibers is best. Linen will also work, as will “Butter Suede” (most ultra suede is too stiff). Avoid fabrics to which the iron may leave an impression. Look for fabrics that have a good stretch on the bias, but have little or no stretch lengthwise or straight across the grain. A lining is not needed unless the fabric is thin.

The Purse Pillow can handle most any fabric, even upholstery fabrics. It does not require a lining. It will have a separately stuffed pillow about 13" x 11" placed inside it. You can make this separately.

YARDAGE

With so many different widths and repeats available today, we find it works best if we give you the actual pattern sizes so you can determine how they will fit on your fabric.

BASKETBALL PILLOW (Regulation Size) (Fabric used in photo is “Butter Suede”)

4 cuts 9 1/2" wide x 12" deep
 4 cuts 10 1/2" wide x 11" deep
 Lining is not needed (unless the fabric is thin)

FOOTBALL PILLOW (Regulation Size) (Fabric used in photo is “Butter Suede”)

4 cuts 13" wide x 9 1/2"
 Lining is not needed (unless fabric is thin)
 24" white shoelace

PURSE PILLOW (13" x 11") (Fabric used in photo, by Waverly)

1 cut.....13 1/2" wide x 19 1/2" deep (pillow back, and front flap)
 1 cut.....13 1/2" wide x 10" deep (flap facing)
 1 cut.....13 1/2" wide x 13" deep (pillow front)
 Lining is not needed for above
 2 cuts (to be used for stuffing).....14" wide x 12" deep
 Button or purchased appliqué for front of pillow.
