



Arched Window Swags I

54" - 74" Wide

Easy installation for inside or outside mount. Top center of swags can loop through a decorative ring, drape over a holdback, or tie up with the beautiful oval rosette (pattern included). Jabot pattern and side panel instructions are also included.

Fabric Suggestions: Soft, lightweight fabrics work best. Pleat stack up will be more difficult with thick bulky fabrics. Side swags are always cut on the upright grain. Top swags can be cut upright or bias. Not recommended for fabrics with a nap. Swags and side panels can use a regular drapery lining. Jabots should be self or contrast lined.

YARDAGE

With so many different fabric widths and repeats available today, we find it works best if we give you the actual pattern sizes so you can determine how they will fit on your fabric.

Everything should be cut as pairs. You will need two cuts to make a pair.

TOP CENTER SWAGS

Upright Cut

54" size	the pattern is	34" wide x 36" deep	40" wide x 43" deep
68" size	the pattern is	37" wide x 36" deep	41" wide x 43" deep
74" size	the pattern is	38" wide x 36" deep	42" wide x 43" deep

There is very little fabric difference in the various sizes since it is the width (not depth) that is involved.

SIDE SWAGS

Upright Cut Only

54" size	the pattern is	35" wide x 34" deep
68" size	the pattern is	35" wide x 40" deep
74" size	the pattern is	35" wide x 43" deep

Same amount of lining will be needed.

Jabot: Should install just under widest part of arch window and hang to window sill. The pattern is 43" wide. Measure your depth and add one inch. Two cuts will be needed for one pair, plus lining.

Side Panel: Should install just under widest part of arch window. Measure your length to reach the floor and add 11" (this includes an 8" puddle). Two cut lengths will be needed for one pair, plus lining.

Rosettes: 3/8 yard will do two rosettes. If swag fabric is being used, scraps will be enough. Decorative rings or holdbacks can be used instead.

Two yards of 1/2" hook and loop tape will be needed.

Yardage for Trims:

Trims must be able to curve.

Each jabot (bottom only)	45"
Each center swag	40"
Each side swag	45"
