



Patterns are for the basic **Square Pillow** and the **Sunburst Pillow**, sizes are 12" through 26". The special way these pillows are cut allows them to finish "square" (no more dog ear comers!). Use the insert liner pattern if you wish to use your own stuffing, or use a purchased pillow insert. The pillow bow pattern is included as well as instructions for adding smooth cord, gathered cord, fringe, and various types of ruffles.

### BASIC SQUARE PILLOW

Fabric suggestions: Fabrics that display a larger pattern in the center of the width may cause some waste. Consider which areas of your fabric you wish to display on the pillow when planning your yardage.

#### YARDAGE

Per pillow.....2 square cuts.....1" larger than finished size.

### SUNBURST PILLOW

Fabric suggestions: Light to medium weight fabrics are best. Soft fabrics are easier. Stiff fabrics such as chintz will work, but are harder to gather. Vertical and horizontal stripes make up well.

#### YARDAGE (54" fabric)

Yardage is for front of pillow only. Back of pillow should be cut from the basic square pillow pattern. A square of lining cut from the basic pillow pattern will also be needed for the sunburst front.

12" pillow - 1 3/8 yards  
 14" pillow - 1 1/2 yards  
 16" pillow - 1 3/4 yards  
 18" pillow - 1 3/4 yards

20" pillow - 1 7/8 yards  
 22" pillow - 2 yards  
 24" pillow - 2 1/4 yards  
 26" pillow - 2 3/8 yards

Two buttons (at least 1 1/4" diameter) will be needed for center of pillow.

#### Trims

In some cases scraps will be enough for self covered cord.

Fringe or purchased cord: Use measurement around outside edge of pillow plus 1". 1/2" wide hook and loop tape will be needed for opening at bottom of pillows.

Pillow bow: 1/2 yard will do four bows.
