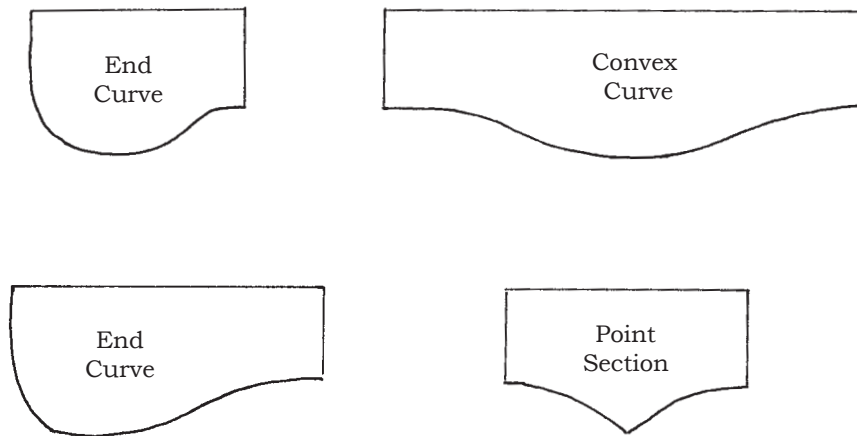


Ondule´ (un´-da-lay) is a French word meaning “wavy or curvy”. This is a mount board with a wavy or curvy face that has a dropped dust board and is covered with fabric. Swags and valances can attach over the top edge as well as under the bottom edge. Pattern and instructions are for the mount board only. Swag and valance instructions are not included. **The face depth should not exceed 4”.**

The pattern for the dust board consist of 4 styles that can be mixed in various ways for an array of designs. The width sizes are adjustable. Projection is determined from the shallowest point to the wall. Deepest part is an additional 1 1/2”.



## SUPPLIES

- 3/4” thick lumber for the dust board (preferably not plywood).
- 3/8” thick bendable plywood (wobble board) for the face.  
This can be ordered from M’Fay Patterns. It needs to be 4” deep and the width your design needs.
- Wood screws
- Quilt batting to pad the face slightly.
- Fabric to cover face, at least 8” deep and wide enough for your design, plus a few inches.
- Enough fabric to cover cord for top and bottom edge of face.
- Hot glue can be used to apply cord.
- “L” Brackets are used for installation, every 3’ to 4’.
