



## Baroque Valance

# 9292

This elegant valance is quite simple to make (although it has a lot of seams). The pleats are tapered to be wide at the bottom and narrow enough at the top to be held by a simple ring or holdback. The valance has to be cut in seven separate pieces, which sew together to finish as one piece (including the jabots). This will create a center straight section with a pointed section at each side, followed by an end section and then a jabot (or an alternative simple return). If you choose, you can repeat as many center straight sections and pointed sections, as you wish.

The center straight section can be 8" wide or as wide as you want. The pointed section finishes 5 1/2" wide (between pleats). The end section finishes 8" wide. As is, the valance is 21 1/2" deep with a short point of 18". The jabot is 35" deep. The depth of the valance can be altered, but all pieces have to be altered to fit each other.

**Fabric Suggestions:** Light to medium weight fabrics that have body. Avoid bulky fabrics. Light weight fabrics can be interlined. Stripes can be used. A contrast lining should be used. Avoid stiff trims. Fringe and other trims should be very short.

## YARDAGE

To determine what size your center straight section needs to be, subtract 5 1/2" for each pointed section and 8" for each end section (if you are making it like the valance shown on the cover, this will be 27"). Subtract this from the size you need. The amount left is the center straight section size.

With so many different fabric widths and repeats available today, we find it works best if we give you the actual pattern sizes you can determine how they will fit on your fabric.

**Upright Cut**            (This pattern cannot be cut seamless)

Center straight section .....	The pattern is.....your width plus 5" x 20" deep
Each pointed section .....	The pattern is ..... 16" wide x 24" deep
Each end section .....	The pattern is ..... 13" wide x 20" deep
Each jabot .....	The pattern is ..... 24" wide x 38" deep
Each return (not needed if using jabot) .....	The pattern is ..... 11" wide x 25" deep

The necessary amount for pleats is automatically included in each pattern piece.

**Lining Pattern Measurements:** There are separate patterns for the lining because the seams must be in different places than the valance seams.

Center straight section .....	The pattern is.... your width plus 11" wide x 20" deep
Each pointed section .....	The pattern is ..... 10" wide x 23" deep
Each end section .....	The pattern is ..... 19" wide x 22" deep
Each jabot .....	The pattern is ..... 24" wide x 38" deep
Each return (not needed if using jabot) .....	The pattern is ..... 8" wide x 25" deep

Same amount of interlining (optional).

### Yardage for Trims

Trims must be able to curve.

(Bottoms only)

Center straight section .....	your width plus 4"
Each pointed section .....	17"
Each end section .....	12"
Each jabot .....	40"
Each return .....	13"
