



Shaped Tiebacks

This package contains patterns for simple, but elegant shaped tiebacks. There are patterns for four different shapes. Each shape comes in sizes 18", 24" and 30". Alteration instructions are not included.

Three different types of construction are given. Tiebacks can range from soft to extremely stiff depending on the type of interfacing and construction used.

Fabric Suggestions: Most any fabric can be used. Lining is also needed. Soft to medium weight tiebacks should have a light or medium weight interfacing or interlining. Extremely stiff tiebacks need a heavy interfacing and 2 pieces of interlining. The interfacing can be heavy weight pellon (fusible is recommended). Skirtex (Or something similar) can also be used. Skirtex is a stiff interfacing used in the trade.

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YARDAGE

With so many different fabric widths and repeats available today, we find it works best if we give you the actual pattern sizes so you can determine how they will fit your fabric.

All measurements below are for a single tieback.

Upright Cut	18"	24"	30"
A The pattern is	19" wide x 11" deep 25" wide x 11" deep 31" wide x 11" deep
B The pattern is	19" wide x 14" deep 25" wide x 14" deep 31" wide x 14" deep
C The pattern is	19" wide x 14" deep 25" wide x 14" deep 31" wide x 14" deep
D The pattern is	19" wide x 12" deep 25" wide x 12" deep 31" wide x 12" deep

Lengthwise Cut: The width measurement will run with the selvage.

Same amount of lining will be needed for all of the above. Interfacing and interlining can also be used. (See Fabric Suggestions.)

Trims: (Trims must be able to curve)

Bottom Only	18"	24"	30"
A	23"	30"	35"
B	26"	31"	36"
C	33"	37"	40"
D	31"	37"	43"



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All Way Around

A	51"	61"	73"
B	53"	64"	76"
C	66"	63"	74"
D	53"	63"	75"
