



Tuscany Curtain

This curtain is created with Italian Stringing. An encased lift cord tape is used to draw the fabric up and sideways at the same time, creating swag like folds and a graceful tail. It can be board or pole mounted, with staples or Velcro®. There is a small pleat at each end which allows some "ease". There is no other fullness across the top edge. It pulls up and is tied off to be stationary.

Width sizes are 20" to 42". For wider windows, a pair can be used on the same mount board, or pole, mirror imaging one another.

Fabric Suggestions: Soft, light to medium weight fabrics work best. Avoid extremely bulky fabrics. The curtain should be self or contrast lined. Interlining can also be used. If trim is not used, you should sew a cord into the seams at the sides and bottom.

YARDAGE

The depth of the stringing pattern limits the sizes of the finished width and length of the curtain.

Recommended Sizes

20" to 22" Finished width.....	can have a 30" to 50" Finished length
23" to 24" Finished width.....	can have a 35" to 55" Finished length
25" to 26" Finished width.....	can have a 35" to 60" Finished length
27" to 28" Finished width.....	can have a 35" to 65" Finished length
29" to 30" Finished width.....	can have a 40" to 70" Finished length
31" to 34" Finished width.....	can have a 40" to 75" Finished length
35" to 36" Finished width.....	can have a 45" to 80" Finished length
37" to 38" Finished width.....	can have a 50" to 85" Finished length
39" to 40" Finished width.....	can have a 50" to 90" Finished length
41" to 42" Finished width.....	can have a 55" to 95" Finished length

Slight variations may be accomplished by moving the stringing pattern up or down on the fabric.

CUT WIDTH.....Finished width, plus returns, plus 7"

CUT LENGTHFinished length, plus 2". (Finished length is when the curtain is down.)

Lining and interlining.....Same amount of lining and interlining (optional) is needed.

TRIM

Bottom.....Finished width, plus returns, plus 7".

Side.....Finished length, plus 1". Trim can go on one side or both.

SUPPLIES

In addition to fabric, lining, interlining, and board (or pole)

Encased lift cord tapeabout 2 1/2 yards per curtain (www.rowleycompany.com)

Plastic rings2 per curtain

Screw eyes1 per curtain

Orb1 per curtain
