


Rosewood Valance

This soft valance consists of two separate valance sections that butt together at the center of the window. You have a choice between two tails. The Rosewood Tail can place over the valance sections. The Curved Tail can place behind the valance sections. The Rosewood Rosette is made and attached separately.



The end corners of the mount board can have a slight curve (pattern inlcuded). This creates an elegant shape to the valance sides. The alternative is to use a regular straight board. The pattern fits windows 36" to 56" wide. The Rosewood Tail is 17" at the deepest part. The Curved Tail is 12" at the shortest part. The Rosewood Rosette is about 7" x 7". Alterations for the depth of the valance and tails are included.

Fabric Suggestions: Medium to heavy fabrics work well. Stripes and plaids can be used. Drapery lining can be used but will tend to show around the edges if trim is not used.

Lining and Interlining: If the fabric has a lot of body and is an upholstery weight, a regular drapery lining may be all you need. Otherwise it is important to add the body of a medium weight interlining. A heavy lining (such as black out) is a good addition. The tails should get the same lining and interlining as the valance. The Rosewood Rosette needs a medium weight interfacing (no interlining).

Trims: Sewing a cord into the bottom seam is a good choice and will help prevent the lining from showing at the bottom edge. Gimp, braid, or fringe trims can also be used.

YARDAGE

Each valance section should be one half your window width.

Upright Cut (The pattern will be placed upright on the fabric. The selvage will be vertical of the window). **Lengthwise Cut** (The pattern will be placed lengthwise on the fabric. The selvage will be horizontal of the window).

Each Valance Section (Cut as a pair)

Rosewood Tail	the pattern is	17" wide x 21" deep
Curved Tail	the pattern is	15" wide x 18" deep
Poinsettia Rosette	the pattern is (cut 4 p	er rosette) 9" wide x 9" deep

Except for the rosettes, same amount of lining and interlining is needed. (Using interlining is optional).

Covered button (for rosette), 1" or smaller, tassels for valance are optional. Medium weight interfacing for the rosette (optional).
