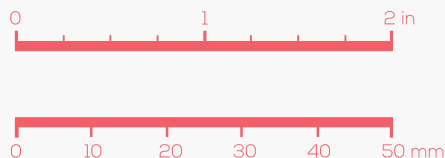


RING SIZING GUIDE

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

- Inside the box on the right, measure both bars with a ruler to confirm the printed paper size.
- Pay extra attention to the accuracy of your measuring.
- We highly recommend to measure your fingers at the end of the day – it is when your finger size will be at its largest.
- DON'T measure your fingers size when it's cold or damp.

CONFIRM PRINTED PAPER SIZE

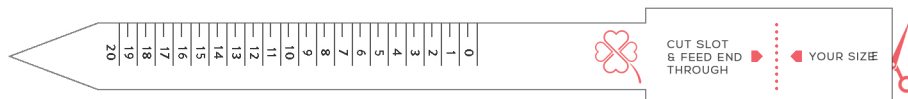


PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Place a ruler next to the bars and measure EXACTLY 2 inches or 50 mm. DON'T measure your finger if the measurement is not accurate.

OPTION 1 MAKE YOUR OWN RING SIZER

1. Cut the ring sizer below.
2. Cut the - - - line on the right side of the ring sizer. Do not cut the entire ring sizer. Only a small cut, to insert to the pointy edge of the ring sizer.
3. Wrap the ring sizer around the WIDEST part of your intended finger. Make sure the numbers are visible and insert the pointy edge through the slit.
4. The number that is near to the slit is your ring size! If can also share 1/4 sizes, if it seems that your size in between



OPTION 2

1. Pick a ring that you wear on the intended finger.
2. Lay the ring on each circle at the time and try to get the best match. NOTICE that you measure the INSIDE diameter of the ring!
3. If the ring falls between 2 sizes, choose the 1/4 size in the middle.
